- * AFTERNOON TEMPERATURES IN THE LOWER AND MID 90S WILL COMBINE WITH OPPRESSIVE HUMIDITY LEVELS TO ONCE AGAIN CREATE HEAT INDICES IN THE 105 TO 110 RANGE.
- * A HEAT INDEX OF 105 IS GENERALLY CONSIDERED THE THRESHOLD WHERE THE BODY WILL BEGIN TO SUCCUMB MORE EASILY TO THE EFFECTS OF THE HEAT... MAKING HEAT EXHAUSTION AND HEAT STROKE A GREATER CONCERN IF PRECAUTIONS ARE NOT TAKEN.

- ... HEAT INDEX READINGS LIKELY TO EXCEED 100 DEGREES AGAIN MONDAY AFTERNOON...
- ON MONDAY... THE COMBINATION OF TEMPERATURES IN THE LOWER AND MIDDLE 90S... ALONG WITH RELATIVE HUMIDITY VALUES NEAR 50 PERCENT ... - A FEW LOCATIONS THAT EXPERIENCE EXTENSIVE CLOUD COVER OR THUNDERSTORMS LATE MONDAY AFTERNOON MAY SEE A SHORTENED DURATION OF THESE ELEVATED HEAT INDEX READINGS.

- GIVEN THE RECENT COOLER WEATHER... YOU MAY NOT BE ACCUSTOMED TO THE HIGHER OUTDOOR TEMPERATURES IN THE LOWER 90S. THESE TEMPERATURES... COMBINED WITH THE HIGHER HUMIDITY WILL PRODUCE HEAT INDEX VALUES BETWEEN 98 AND 103 DEGREES THIS AFTERNOON.
