Stoddard County, Missouri - The National Weather Service in Paducah, Kentucky has issued a Winter Weather Advisory for Stoddard County, Missouri.

... WINTER WEATHER ADVISORY IN EFFECT FROM 6 PM THIS EVENING TO 6 AM CST SUNDAY

... THE NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE IN PADUCAH HAS ISSUED A WINTER WEATHER ADVISORY

... WHICH IS IN EFFECT FROM 6 PM THIS EVENING TO 6 AM CST SUNDAY.

* ANOTHER BLAST OF ARCTIC AIR TONIGHT WILL CHANGE RAIN TO A LIGHT WINTRY MIX OF FREEZING OR FROZEN PRECIPITATION TONIGHT.

* TIMING: RAIN CHANGING TO FREEZING RAIN AND POSSIBLY MIXED WITH A LITTLE SLEET AT TIMES... 6 PM TO 9 PM...

... . MOUNT VERNON TO PERRYVILLE 9 PM TO MIDNIGHT... EVANSVILLE

TO PADUCAH MIDNIGHT TO 3 AM... OWENSBORO TO MAYFIELD 3 AM TO 6 AM... ... CADIZ TO HOPKINSVILLE * MAIN IMPACT: ICY ROAD CONDITIONS

... QUICK FREEZING SLICK SPOTS DEVELOPING. LIGHT ACCUMULATIONS OF FREEZING RAIN

... SLEET OR SNOW WILL CAUSE OVERNIGHT TRAVEL HAZARDS AS SLICK SPOTS QUICKLY DEVELOP ON AREA ROADWAYS. * OTHER IMPACTS: FLASH FREEZING OF WET ROADS AS TEMPERATURE PLUMMETS BELOW 32 DEGREES QUICKLY TONIGHT. LIGHT COATING OF SNOW POSSIBLE TOO BEFORE RAINY AND ICY PRECIPITATION ENDS. PRECAUTIONARY/PREPAREDNESS ACTIONS

Stoddard County, Missouri - The National Weather Service in Paducah, Kentucky has issued a Special Weather Statement for Stoddard County.

... IMPACTS FROM FREEZING ROADWAYS MAY BE FELT IN MANY LOCATIONS SATURDAY EVENING INTO THE OVERNIGHT HOURS

...TEMPERATURES WILL WARM SUBSTANTIALLY OVERNIGHT AS SOUTHERLY WINDS CONTINUE. A FEW THUNDERSTORMS WITH GUSTY WINDS MAY EVEN OCCUR BY SATURDAY BY AFTERNOON AHEAD OF AN ADVANCING ARCTIC FRONT

... ESPECIALLY OVER WESTERN KENTUCKY. THIS COLD FRONT WILL BRING A VERY RAPID CHANGE TO SUB FREEZING TEMPERATURES FROM NORTHWEST TO SOUTHEAST DURING THE LATE AFTERNOON AND EVENING HOURS. MANY LOCATIONS WILL DROP FROM THE UPPER 50S AND LOWER 60S TO NEAR FREEZING WITHIN A 6 HOUR TIME PERIOD SATURDAY AFTERNOON AND EVENING. WITH SHOWERS AND THUNDERSTORMS EXPECTED AHEAD OF THE FRONT

... ESPECIALLY ALONG AND SOUTH OF THE OHIO RIVER

... VERY WET ROADWAYS WILL LIKELY PROCEED THE CHANGE TO FREEZING CONDITIONS. THE RESULT COULD BE FREEZING OF ANY PUDDLES OR LEFT OVER WET ROADWAYS DURING THE EVENING. ELEVATED ROADWAYS WILL BE THE FIRST TO FREEZE. IN ADDITION

... THERE ARE INDICATIONS THAT A BAND OF FREEZING RAIN COULD FORM BEHIND THE COLD FRONT SATURDAY EVENING

... ESPECIALLY ALONG AND SOUTHEAST OF THE OHIO RIVER. THIS SITUATION WILL NEED TO BE MONITORED VERY CLOSELY

... AS IMPACTS FROM THIS EVENT COULD BE GREATER ON AREA ROADWAYS. IN ADDITION

... WIND CHILL VALUES BY SUNRISE SUNDAY WILL LIKELY BE DOWN NEAR ZERO TO THE LOWER TEENS. PLEASE STAY TUNED TO THE LATEST FORECASTS LATER TONIGHT INTO SATURDAY.

US SPECIAL WEATHER STATEMENT UNTIL 5PM CST THU

...FIRE DANGER FURTHER ELEVATED BY STRONG GUSTY WINDS TODAY

... THE COMBINATION OF EXTREMELY DRY FUELS

...LOW RELATIVE HUMIDITY

... AND STRONG GUSTY WINDS WILL RESULT IN AN ELEVATED FIRE DANGER TODAY. BURN BANS ARE CURRENTLY IN EFFECT FOR MANY LOCAL COUNTIES. EVEN WHERE BURN BANS ARE NOT IN EFFECT

...BURNING TODAY IS NOT RECOMMENDED AS ANY FIRE ACTIVITY COULD EASILY GET OUT OF CONTROL. SOME RELIEF FROM THE DRY CONDITIONS IS EXPECTED FRIDAY AS RAIN SHOWERS ACCOMPANY THE PASSAGE OF A STRONG COLD FRONT. HOWEVER

... THE RELIEF WILL ONLY BE TEMPORARY AS RAINFALL TOTALS ARE ONLY FORECAST BETWEEN ONE THIRD AND ONE HALF INCH.

... FREEZE WARNING IN EFFECT FROM MIDNIGHT TONIGHT TO 8 AM CST SUNDAY

... THE NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE IN PADUCAH HAS ISSUED A FREEZE WARNING

... WHICH IS IN EFFECT FROM MIDNIGHT TONIGHT TO 8 AM CST SUNDAY.
* TEMPERATURES... A WIDESPREAD FREEZE IS ANTICIPATED TONIGHT ACROSS THE ENTIRE QUAD STATE REGION. TEMPERATURES ARE EXPECTED TO DIP TO NEAR OR BELOW FREEZING SHORTLY AFTER MIDNIGHT

... THEN REMAIN BELOW THE FREEZING MARK FOR SEVERAL HOURS THROUGH AROUND 8 AM OR SO. * IMPACTS

... SUB-FREEZING TEMPERATURES AT NIGHT CAN KILL MOST SENSITIVE VEGETATION. POTTED PLANTS NORMALLY LEFT OUTDOORS SHOULD BE BROUGHT INSIDE AWAY FROM THE COLD.
PRECAUTIONARY/PREPAREDNESS ACTIONS

... A FREEZE WARNING MEANS SUB-FREEZING TEMPERATURES ARE IMMINENT OR HIGHLY LIKELY. THESE CONDITIONS WILL KILL CROPS AND OTHER SENSITIVE VEGETATION.

US SPECIAL WEATHER STATEMENT UNTIL 4AM CST WED ...WIDESPREAD FROST POSSIBLE WEDNESDAY NIGHT IN SOME AREAS

... CHILLY HIGH PRESSURE SPREADING EAST FROM THE SOUTHERN PLAINS WEDNESDAY NIGHT WILL PRODUCE CLEAR AND CALM CONDITIONS OVER THE QUAD STATE REGION. THIS WILL ALLOW TEMPERATURES TO FALL OFF INTO THE 30S LATE WEDNESDAY NIGHT. AREAS OF FROST WILL BE LIKELY IN MANY LOCATIONS

...AND SOME AREAS MAY RECEIVE A WIDESPREAD FROST. THE MOST LIKELY PLACES TO SEE WIDESPREAD FROST WILL BE OVER SOUTHERN ILLINOIS AND SOME LOCATIONS IN SOUTHEAST MISSOURI ALONG THE MISSISSIPPI RIVER AND IN THE OZARK FOOTHILLS. IN THOSE REGIONS

SPECIAL WEATHER STATEMENT UNTIL 5:30PM CDT TUE ...

ELEVATED FIRE DANGER TO CONTINUE THIS AFTERNOON...

TEMPERATURES IN THE LOWER TO MIDDLE 80S COMBINED WITH LOW AFTERNOON RELATIVE HUMIDITY AND SOUTHWEST WINDS 10 TO 20 MPH WITH HIGHER GUSTS WILL CONTINUE TO RESULT IN AN ELEVATED FIRE DANGER.

THERE HAS BEEN A REPORT OF A FIELD FIRE IN MCCRACKEN COUNTY ALONG 10000 OGDEN LANDING ROAD.

BURNING IS NOT RECOMMENDED FOR THE REST OF THE AFTERNOON GIVEN THE VERY DRY AND BREEZY CONDITIONS ACROSS SOUTHEAST MISSOURI...SOUTHERN ILLINOIS...SOUTHWEST INDIANA AND WEST KENTUCKY.
