**Stoddard County, Missouri** - The National Weather Service in Paducah, Kentucky has issued a Wind Advisory for Stoddard County, Missouri.

... WIND ADVISORY IN EFFECT FROM 5 AM TO 4 PM CDT WEDNESDAY...

THE NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE IN PADUCAH HAS ISSUED A WIND ADVISORY... WHICH IS IN EFFECT FROM 5 AM TO 4 PM CDT WEDNESDAY FOR ALL OF SOUTHERN ILLINOIS... SOUTHEAST MISSOURI... SOUTHWEST INDIANA AND WEST KENTUCKY.

\* TIMING: STRONG NORTHERLY WINDS REACHING WIND ADVISORY LEVELS WILL MOVE OVER SOUTHWEST ILLINOIS NEAR THE INTERSTATE 64... 57 INTERCHANGE TO THE FOOT HILLS OF SOUTHEAST MISSOURI BY 5 AM CDT. THESE WINDS WILL THEN COVER THE REST OF THE QUAD STATE REGION BY 10 AM CDT. WINDS WILL GRADUALLY

LESSEN OVER SOUTHWEST ILLINOIS AND SOUTHEAST MISSOURI AROUND NOON... AND THE REST OF THE AREA AROUND 4 PM CDT.

\* WINDS: SUSTAINED WINDS OF 25 TO 30 MPH... WITH WIND GUSTS BETWEEN 45 TO 50 MPH ARE EXPECTED TO RAPIDLY SPREAD ACROSS THE REGION BEFORE 10 AM CDT. THE WINDS SHOULD FALL BELOW WIND ADVISORY LEVEL ACROSS THE ENTIRE QUAD STATE REGION AFTER 4 PM CDT... BUT STILL GUST BETWEEN 25 AND 35 MPH EVEN THROUGH THE EARLY EVENING HOURS.

\* IMPACTS: FOR TRAVELERS DRIVING ALONG WEST TO EAST ORIENTED ROADS... THE WINDS WILL CAUSE SOME DIFFICULTY IN STEERING. THIS WILL BE ESPECIALLY TRUE FOR HIGH PROFILE VEHICLES SUCH AS TRACTOR TRAILERS AND RECREATIONAL VEHICLES. SOME TREE LIMBS AND TREES WEAKENED BY RECENT WINTRY EVENTS MAY FALL AND COULD IMPACT NEARBY STRUCTURES OR POWER LINES. ANY UNSECURED OBJECTS LEFT OUTDOORS MAY BE TOSSED AROUND AS WELL.

PRECAUTIONARY/PREPAREDNESS ACTIONS...

A WIND ADVISORY IS ISSUED WHEN SUSTAINED WINDS ARE EXPECTED TO REACH 30 MPH OR GREATER FOR LONGER THAN ONE HOUR... OR WIND GUSTS ARE EXPECTED TO REACH 45 MPH FOR ANY DURATION.

... STRONG NORTH WINDS TO MOVE IN BEHIND COLD FRONT ON WEDNESDAY...

.AN INTENSE GRADIENT OF PRESSURE WILL MOVE IN BEHIND A COLD FRONT OVERNIGHT. STRONG WINDS... CAPABLE OF PRODUCING SUSTAINED WINDS OF 25 TO 30 MPH... WITH WIND GUSTS IN EXCESS OF 45 MPH WILL BE POSSIBLE SHORTLY BEFORE DAYBREAK WEDNESDAY... GRADUALLY DIMINISHING BY LATE WEDNESDAY AFTERNOON FROM NORTHWEST TO SOUTHEAST ACROSS THE QUAD STATE REGION.

**Stoddard County, Missouri** - The National Weather Service in Paducah, Kentucky has issued a Freezing Fog Advisory.

... FREEZING FOG ADVISORY IN EFFECT UNTIL 8 AM CST THIS MORNING...

THE NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE IN PADUCAH HAS ISSUED A

FREEZING FOG ADVISORY... WHICH IS IN EFFECT UNTIL 8 AM CST THIS MORNING.

\* TIMING... FREEZING FOG WILL PERSIST UNTIL MID MORNING.

\* VISIBILITY... VISIBILITY WILL BE ONE HALF MILE OR LESS IN MOST LOCATIONS.

\* IMPACTS... FREEZING FOG WILL LEAVE A THIN GLAZE OF ICE ON MANY SURFACES. HAZARDOUS DRIVING CONDITIONS ARE EXPECTED DUE TO A COMBINATION OF POOR VISIBILITY AND ICE ON ROADWAYS.

PRECAUTIONARY/PREPAREDNESS ACTIONS...

A FREEZING FOG ADVISORY MEANS VISIBILITIES WILL FREQUENTLY BE REDUCED TO LESS THAN ONE QUARTER MILE. IF DRIVING... SLOW DOWN... USE YOUR HEADLIGHTS... AND LEAVE PLENTY OF DISTANCE AHEAD OF YOU. ALSO... BE ALERT FOR FROST ON BRIDGE DECKS CAUSING SLIPPERY ROADS.

AREAS OF DENSE FREEZING FOG EARLY THIS MORNING WERE BEING CAUSED BY A SOUTHEAST WIND FLOW OF MILDER AIR OVER SNOW COVERED GROUND.

**Stoddard County, Missouri** - The National Weather Service in Paducah, Kentucky has extended the Winter Storm Warning until 11:00 a.m. on Monday.

**... WINTER STORM WARNING REMAINS IN EFFECT UNTIL NOON CST  
MONDAY...**

A WINTER STORM WARNING REMAINS IN EFFECT UNTIL NOON CST MONDAY.

\* SLEET WILL TRANSITION OVER TO SNOW THIS EVENING OVER SOUTHERN ILLINOIS AND SOUTHWEST INDIANA... AND THEN LATER TONIGHT OVER WESTERN KENTUCKY AND FAR SOUTHEAST MISSOURI. SNOW WILL EVENTUALLY TAPER OFF AROUND SUNRISE MONDAY.

\* HEAVY ACCUMULATIONS OF SLEET AND SNOW ARE EXPECTED. SNOW ACCUMULATIONS OF FOUR TO EIGHT INCHES ARE EXPECTED TONIGHT INTO EARLY MONDAY. A FULL INCH OF SLEET MAY OCCUR IN SOME LOCATIONS ALONG THE OHIO RIVER BEFORE THE TRANSITION TO SNOW. LOCALIZED BANDING AND THUNDER WILL ALSO BE POSSIBLE... WHICH COULD LEAD TO SOME ISOLATED HIGHER ACCUMULATIONS.

\* IMPACTS... TRAVEL CONDITIONS WILL BECOME PROGRESSIVELY MORE TREACHEROUS THROUGH THE NIGHT TIME HOURS.

# UPDATE: Significant Sleet and Snow Expected Sunday Night

## UPDATE: Significant Sleet and Snow Expected Sunday Night

A major winter storm will affect much of the central U.S. Sunday and Monday, dumping several inches of snow after laying down a coating of freezing rain and sleet in many areas. The precipitation will come in waves and not all at once. The first wave of winter weather will mainly affect northern and central Missouri, where 4 to 8 inches of snow will fall Sunday. The second wave will have the greatest impact on Southeast Missouri and Stoddard County, likely arriving Sunday evening and overnight, ending midday Monday. Travel is not advised anywhere in the region beginning Sunday afternoon through Monday afternoon.

Latest data suggests the atmosphere will be colder aloft, likely preventing a significant build up of ice on trees and power lines from freezing rain in Stoddard County.

Rather, minor amounts of freezing rain will occur first Sunday afternoon and evening, followed by a changeover to several hours of heavy sleet Sunday night, then ending as a few inches of snow Monday morning. The combination of all three of these precipitation types, along with bitter temperatures in the teens and single digits following the storm, will make travel EXTREMELY hazardous for many hours after the precipitation has ended.

My forecast amounts are below (margin of error +/- 1"):

**DEXTER:** 0.25" freezing rain, 1" sleet, 4" snow

**POPLAR BLUFF:** 0.25" freezing rain, 0.75" sleet, 5" snow

**SIKESTON:** 0.5" freezing rain, 1" sleet, 3" snow

**CAPE GIRARDEAU:** 0.25" freezing rain, 0.5" sleet, 6" snow

**Stoddard County, Missouri** - The National Weather Service in Paducah, Kentucky has issued a Winter Storm Warning for Stoddard County.

... WINTER STORM WARNING IN EFFECT FROM 6 AM CST SUNDAY TO 6 AM CST MONDAY...

THE NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE IN PADUCAH HAS ISSUED A WINTER STORM WARNING FOR ICE... SNOW... AND SLEET ACCUMULATIONS... WHICH IS IN EFFECT FROM 6 AM SUNDAY TO 6 AM CST MONDAY. THE WARNING AREA IS GENERALLY NORTH AND WEST OF A LINE FROM ROCKPORT INDIANA TO NEW MADRID MISSOURI. THE WINTER STORM WATCH FOR THIS AREA IS NO LONGER IN EFFECT.

\* TIMING... EARLY SUNDAY MORNING THROUGH EARLY MONDAY MORNING.

\* AMOUNTS... MODERATE ACCUMULATIONS OF ICE... SLEET... AND SNOW ARE EXPECTED. SNOW AND SLEET ACCUMULATIONS OF FOUR TO SIX INCHES ARE EXPECTED MAINLY ALONG THE INTERSTATE 64 CORRIDOR... TAPERING OFF TO AROUND TWO INCHES AS YOU HEAD SOUTH AND EAST TO THE PURCHASE AREA OF WESTERN KENTUCKY. MOST OF SOUTHEAST MISSOURI IS EXPECTED TO RECEIVE LESS THAN TWO INCHES OF SNOW AND SLEET. ICE ACCUMULATIONS ARE EXPECTED TO RANGE FROM A QUARTER INCH OVER SOUTHEAST ILLINOIS TO A HALF INCH OVER THE SOUTHERN PURCHASE AREA OF WESTERN KENTUCKY.

\* IMPACTS... AS THE PRECIPITATION CHANGES TO FREEZING OR FROZEN... TRAVEL CONDITIONS WILL BECOME TREACHEROUS... ESPECIALLY SUNDAY AND SUNDAY NIGHT. TREE DAMAGE AND POWER OUTAGES WILL BE POSSIBLE.

**... WINTER STORM WATCH IN EFFECT FROM LATE SATURDAY NIGHT THROUGH MONDAY MORNING...**

THE NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE IN PADUCAH HAS ISSUED A WINTER STORM WATCH... WHICH IS IN EFFECT FROM LATE SATURDAY NIGHT THROUGH MONDAY MORNING.

\* TIMING: STARTING AFTER MIDNIGHT SATURDAY NIGHT THROUGH MIDDAY MONDAY GENERALLY NORTH AND WEST OF A LINE FROM ROCKPORT INDIANA TO NEW MADRID MISSOURI.

\* MAIN IMPACT: SIGNIFICANT ICE... SNOW... AND SLEET ACCUMULATIONS ARE EXPECTED.

\* OTHER IMPACTS: SNOW AND ICE COVERED ROADWAYS WILL RESULT IN EXTREMELY DANGEROUS TRAVEL CONDITIONS. ICE ACCUMULATION ON TREES AND POWER LINES WILL LIKELY CAUSE TREE DAMAGE AS WELL AS SOME POWER OUTAGES.
