extended the HEAT ADVISORY until 7:00 p.m. this evening.

...HEAT ADVISORY REMAINS IN EFFECT UNTIL 7 PM CDT THIS EVENING...
A HEAT ADVISORY REMAINS IN EFFECT UNTIL 7 PM CDT THIS EVENING.

* EXCESSIVE HEAT AND HUMIDITY ARE EXPECTED TO DEVELOP AGAIN THIS AFTERNOON.

* AIR TEMPERATURES WILL PEAK IN THE LOWER TO MIDDLE 90S AGAIN THIS AFTERNOON. THESE TEMPERATURES WILL COMBINE WITH HIGH HUMIDITY TO PRODUCE AFTERNOON HEAT INDEX VALUES FROM 100 TO 105.

* THIS PROLONGED PERIOD OF EXTREME HEAT AND HUMIDITY WILL CONTINUE TO CREATE A SITUATION IN WHICH HEAT ILLNESSES ARE POSSIBLE. TAKE EXTRA PRECAUTIONS IF YOU WORK OR SPEND TIME OUTSIDE. 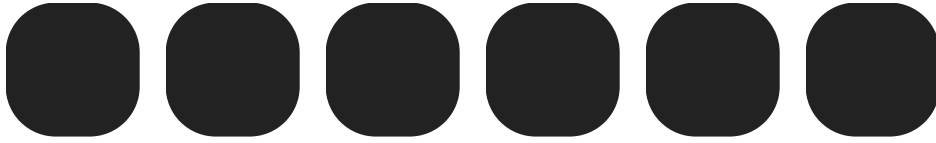

Stoddard County, Missouri - The National Weather Service in Paducah Kentucky has issued a HEAT ADVISORY from Noon today - Saturday 7:00 p.m. for Stoddard County.

... HEAT ADVISORY IN EFFECT FROM NOON TODAY TO 7 PM CDT SATURDAY...

THE NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE IN PADUCAH HAS ISSUED A HEAT ADVISORY... WHICH IS IN EFFECT FROM NOON TODAY TO 7 PM CDT SATURDAY.

* TEMPERATURES WILL BEGIN TO CLIM WELL INTO THE 90S OVER THE NEXT SEVERAL DAYS AS HIGH PRESSURE ALOFT BUILDS NORTH FROM THE GULF COAST REGION. THESE TEMPERATURES WILL COMBINE WITH RATHER MUGGY CONDITIONS TO PRODUCE AFTERNOON HEAT INDEX VALUES FROM 100 TO 105 OR SO SEVERAL DAYS IN A ROW.

* THE COMBINATION OF HOT TEMPERATURES AND HIGH HUMIDITY WILL CREATE A SITUATION IN WHICH HEAT ILLNESSES ARE POSSIBLE. TAKE EXTRA PRECAUTIONS IF YOU WORK OR SPEND TIME OUTSIDE. WHEN POSSIBLE... RESCHEDULE STRENUOUS ACTIVITIES TO EARLY MORNING OR EVENING. KNOW THE SIGNS AND SYMPTOMS OF HEAT EXHAUSTION AND HEAT STROKE. WEAR LIGHT WEIGHT AND LOOSE FITTING CLOTHING WHEN POSSIBLE AND DRINK PLENTY OF WATER.

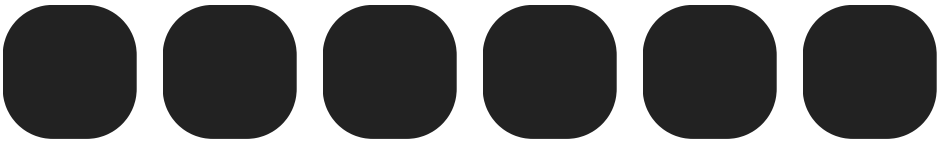
