Winter Storm Warning for Stoddard County

Stoddard County, Missouri - The National Weather Service in Paducah, Kentucky has issued a WINTER STORM WARNING for Stoddard County and parts of southeast Missouri.

WINTER STORM WARNING IN EFFECT FROM 6 PM THIS EVENING TO 6 AM CST MONDAY...

THE NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE IN PADUCAH HAS ISSUED A WINTER STORM WARNING FOR SLEET AND SNOW... WHICH IS IN EFFECT FROM 6 PM THIS EVENING TO 6 AM CST MONDAY. THE WINTER WEATHER ADVISORY IS NO LONGER IN EFFECT.

* TIMING... WINTRY PRECIPITATION WILL BECOME LIKELY BY THIS EVENING OVER MUCH OF THE AREA. ANY RAIN AT ONSET LATE TODAY SHOULD TRANSITION TO SLEET THEN SNOW THROUGH THE EARLY EVENING HOURS.

* SNOWFALL AMOUNTS... INCLUDING SOME SLEET... SHOULD RANGE FROM 3 TO 5 INCHES BEFORE THE SNOW TAPERS OFF LATER TONIGHT.

* IMPACTS... HAZARDOUS DRIVING CONDITIONS WILL BE THE MAIN IMPACT. CONDITIONS WILL CONTINUE TO BE QUITE HAZARDOUS DURING THE MORNING COMMUTE ON MONDAY. STRONG WEST TO NORTHWEST WINDS GUSTING UP TO 30 MPH ON MONDAY MAY CAUSE SOME BLOWING AND DRIFTING OF THE SNOW.

PRECAUTIONARY/PREPAREDNESS ACTIONS...

A WINTER STORM WARNING MEANS SIGNIFICANT AMOUNTS OF SNOW... SLEET... AND ICE ARE EXPECTED OR OCCURRING. STRONG WINDS ARE ALSO POSSIBLE. THIS WILL MAKE TRAVEL VERY HAZARDOUS OR IMPOSSIBLE.

Stoddard County, Missouri - The National Weather Service in Paducah, Kentucky has issued a WINTER WEATHER ADVISORY for Stoddard County and parts of southeast Missouri.

.. WINTER WEATHER ADVISORY REMAINS IN EFFECT FROM 6 PM THIS EVENING TO 6 AM CST MONDAY...

A WINTER WEATHER ADVISORY FOR SNOW AND SLEET REMAINS IN EFFECT FROM 6 PM THIS EVENING TO 6 AM CST MONDAY.

* TIMING... WINTRY PRECIPITATION WILL BECOME LIKELY BY THIS EVENING ACROSS PORTIONS OF SOUTHEAST MISSOURI... SOUTHERN ILLINOIS AND SOUTHWEST INDIANA. ANY RAIN AT ONSET LATE TODAY

SHOULD TRANSITION TO SLEET THEN SNOW THROUGH THE EARLY EVENING HOURS. FARTHER SOUTH INTO WEST KENTUCKY... MORE IN THE WAY OF RAIN AND POSSIBLY SLEET IS EXPECTED TO START LATE TODAY INTO THE EARLY EVENING... FOLLOWED BY A TRANSITION TO SLEET AND THEN SNOW THIS EVENING AND OVERNIGHT

* ACCUMULATIONS... SNOWFALL AMOUNTS... INCLUDING SOME SLEET... FROM 1 TO 3 INCHES IS EXPECTED FROM THE EVANSVILLE TRI STATE REGION... WEST ACROSS SOUTHERN ILLINOIS INTO PORTIONS OF SOUTHEAST MISSOURI. FROM THE LAND BETWEEN THE LAKES AREA EAST INTO THE PENNYRILE REGION OF WEST KENTUCKY... AMOUNTS MAY BE A BIT LOWER. THERE MAY ALSO BE A BRIEF PERIOD OF FREEZING RAIN IN THIS AREA.

* IMPACTS... HAZARDOUS DRIVING CONDITIONS WILL BE THE MAIN IMPACT SUNDAY NIGHT... POSSIBLY LASTING INTO THE MORNING COMMUTE HOURS MONDAY.

PRECAUTIONARY/PREPAREDNESS ACTIONS...

Stoddard County, Missouri - The National Weather Service in Paducah, Kentucky has issued a WEATHER STATEMENT for Stoddard County and parts of southeast Missouri.

WINTER WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR SUNDAY NIGHT...

A STORM SYSTEM IS EXPECTED TO DEVELOP OVER THE NORTHERN GULF OF MEXICO LATER THIS WEEKEND... AND MOVE NORTHEAST INTO SOUTHERN ALABAMA SUNDAY EVENING. THE SYSTEM SHOULD THROW MOISTURE NORTHWARD INTO QUITE COLD AIR THAT WILL BE IN PLACE OVER THE LOWER OHIO VALLEY SUNDAY NIGHT. THIS MAY RESULT IN SOME SNOW ACCUMULATIONS OVER MUCH OF THE QUAD STATE REGION. IT IS TOO EARLY AT THIS TIME TO SPECULATE ON SPECIFIC AMOUNTS OR DETAILS. HOWEVER... THERE DOES SEEM SOME POTENTIAL FOR TRAVEL IMPACTS AS WE NEAR THE MORNING RUSH MONDAY MORNING.

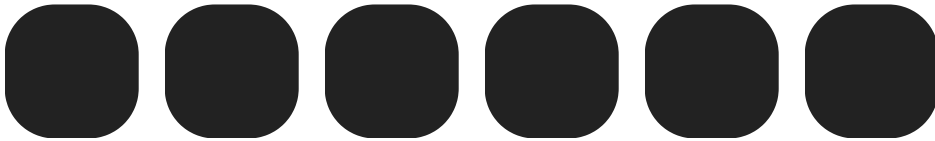

Stoddard County, Missouri - The National Weather Service in Paducah, Kentucky has issued a FREEZE Warning!

... FREEZE WARNING IN EFFECT FROM MIDNIGHT CDT FRIDAY NIGHT TO 8 AM CST SUNDAY...

THE NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE IN PADUCAH HAS ISSUED A FREEZE WARNING... WHICH IS IN EFFECT FROM MIDNIGHT CDT FRIDAY NIGHT TO 8 AM CST SUNDAY. THE FREEZE WATCH IS NO LONGER IN EFFECT.

* TEMPERATURES WILL DROP BELOW AT OR BELOW THE FREEZING MARK BY MIDNIGHT FRIDAY NIGHT OVER SOUTHWEST ILLINOIS... THEN SPREAD SOUTHEAST ACROSS THE REST OF THE REGION THROUGH THE OVERNIGHT HOURS SATURDAY MORNING. TEMPERATURES SATURDAY MORNING WILL RANGE FROM 26 TO 31 DEGREES.

FOR SATURDAY NIGHT AND SUNDAY... TEMPERATURES SHOULD DROP BELOW FREEZING NO LATER THAN 10 PM CDT SATURDAY NIGHT... WITH LOWS RANGING BETWEEN 26 AND 32 DEGREES.

TEMPERATURES SHOULD RISE ABOVE FREEZING AFTER 9 AM CDT ON SATURDAY AND 8 AM CST ON SUNDAY.

* IMPACTS WILL BE TWOFOLD. COLD TEMPERATURES SATURDAY AND SUNDAY WILL DAMAGE SENSITIVE PLANTS LEFT UNCOVERED AND LEFT OUTDOORS. MODERATE TO HEAVY FROST EXPECTED SATURDAY NIGHT AND SUNDAY WILL ALSO DAMAGE PLANTS. THE COLD TEMPERATURES WILL PUT AN END TO THE OUTDOOR GROWING SEASON.

PRECAUTIONARY/PREPAREDNESS ACTIONS...

A FREEZE WARNING MEANS SUB-FREEZING TEMPERATURES ARE IMMINENT OR HIGHLY LIKELY. THESE CONDITIONS WILL KILL CROPS AND OTHER SENSITIVE VEGETATION.

... FIRST WIDESPREAD FREEZING TEMPERATURES OF THE SEASON EXPECTED THIS WEEKEND...

.CANADIAN HIGH PRESSURE WILL USHER IN MUCH COLDER AIR INTO THE QUAD STATE REGION BEHIND A COLD FRONTAL PASSAGE ON FRIDAY. AS THE WINDS DIMINISH AND SKIES CLEAR OUT... CONDITIONS WILL BE

FAVORABLE FOR FREEZING TEMPERATURES LATE FRIDAY NIGHT INTO SATURDAY MORNING... AND AGAIN SATURDAY NIGHT INTO SUNDAY MORNING. ALTHOUGH FREEZING TEMPERATURES WILL BE THE PRIMARY CONCERN... 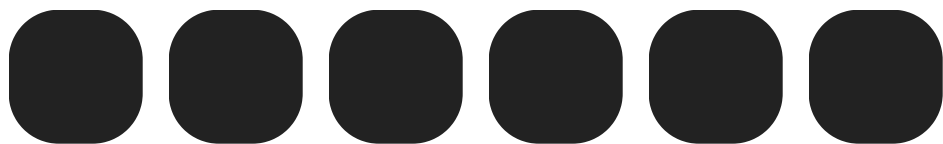
