### Winter Storm Warning Issued for Stoddard County

**Stoddard County, Missouri** - The National Weather Service in Paducah, Kentucky has issued a WINTER STORM WARNING!

- ... WINTER STORM WARNING IN EFFECT UNTIL 6 AM CST SATURDAY...
- THE NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE IN PADUCAH HAS ISSUED A WINTER STORM WARNING FOR SOUTHEAST MISSOURI... SOUTHERN ILLINOIS... SOUTHWEST INDIANA AND WEST KENTUCKY... WHICH IS IN EFFECT UNTIL 6 AM CST SATURDAY. THE WINTER WEATHER ADVISORY IS NO LONGER IN EFFECT.
- \* TIMING: LATE THIS AFTERNOON THROUGH EARLY SATURDAY MORNING.
- \* AMOUNTS: SNOW AND SLEET ACCUMULATIONS WILL RANGE FROM 2 TO 4 INCHES ACROSS SOUTHWEST INDIANA TO A HALF AN INCH OR LESS ACROSS MUCH OF SOUTHEAST MISSOURI. ICE

ACCUMULATIONS WILL RANGE FROM AROUND A QUARTER INCH OVER MUCH OF SOUTHEAST MISSOURI TO A TENTH OF AN INCH OVER SOUTHWEST INDIANA. AREAS THAT EXPERIENCE A THUNDERSTORM COULD SEE ISOLATED HIGHER AMOUNTS OF ICE... SLEET OR SNOW.

- \* IMPACTS: TRAVEL CONDITIONS WILL DETERIORATE QUICKLY AS THE PRECIPITATION BEGINS. AREAS THAT GET ENHANCED ICING DUE TO THUNDERSTORMS COULD EXPERIENCE A FEW ISOLATED POWER OUTAGES. CONDITIONS SHOULD IMPROVE AS TEMPERATURES CLIMB ABOVE FREEZING FROM SOUTH TO NORTH EARLY SATURDAY.
- PRECAUTIONARY/PREPAREDNESS ACTIONS...
- A WINTER STORM WARNING MEANS SIGNIFICANT AMOUNTS OF SNOW... SLEET... AND ICE ARE EXPECTED OR OCCURRING. STRONG WINDS ARE ALSO POSSIBLE. THIS WILL MAKE TRAVEL VERY HAZARDOUS OR IMPOSSIBLE.

- ... SNOW AND ICE ACCUMULATIONS EXPECTED LATE THIS AFTERNOON AND TONIGHT...
- .A STRONG WARM FRONT WILL MOVE THROUGH THE REGION TONIGHT. WITH ARCTIC AIR IN PLACE AHEAD OF IT... PRECIPITATION WILL QUICKLY TRANSITION FROM SNOW AND SLEET TO FREEZING RAIN THIS EVENING. TEMPERATURES WILL EVENTUALLY CLIMB ABOVE FREEZING EARLY SATURDAY.

**Stoddard County, Missouri** - The National Weather Service has issued a WINTER WEATHER ADVISORY beginning at noon for Stoddard County.

- ... WINTER WEATHER ADVISORY IN EFFECT FROM NOON TODAY TO 6 AM CST SATURDAY...
- THE NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE IN PADUCAH HAS ISSUED A WINTER WEATHER ADVISORY FOR SNOW... SLEET... AND FREEZING

RAIN WHICH IS IN EFFECT FROM NOON TODAY TO 6 AM CST SATURDAY. THE WINTER STORM WATCH IS NO LONGER IN EFFECT.

- \* TIMING: SNOW AND SLEET WILL BEGIN TO DEVELOP ACROSS THE AREA BY MIDDAY. THE PRECIPITATION WILL INTENSIFY AND TRANSITION TO FREEZING RAIN TONIGHT. TEMPERATURES WILL WARM TO ABOVE FREEZING BY EARLY SATURDAY.
- \* MAIN IMPACT: A COMBINATION OF SNOW AND SLEET ACCUMULATIONS UNDERNEATH A THIN LAYER OF ICE WILL CREATE A PERIOD OF VERY HAZARDOUS DRIVING CONDITIONS... ESPECIALLY THIS EVENING.
- \* UP TO 2 INCHES OF SNOW AND SLEET ARE POSSIBLE ACROSS THE ADVISORY AREA... ESPECIALLY EAST OF THE MISSISSIPPI RIVER. UP TO A TENTH OF AN INCH OF ICE ACCUMULATION IS POSSIBLE NEAR THE TENNESSEE AND ARKANSAS BORDERS.
- PRECAUTIONARY/PREPAREDNESS ACTIONS...
- A WINTER WEATHER ADVISORY MEANS THAT PERIODS OF SNOW... SLEET... OR FREEZING RAIN WILL CAUSE TRAVEL DIFFICULTIES. BE PREPARED FOR SLIPPERY ROADS AND LIMITED VISIBILITIES... AND USE CAUTION WHILE DRIVING.



- ... WINTER STORM WATCH IN EFFECT FROM FRIDAY AFTERNOON THROUGH LATE FRIDAY NIGHT...
- THE NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE IN PADUCAH HAS ISSUED A WINTER STORM WATCH... WHICH IS IN EFFECT FROM FRIDAY AFTERNOON THROUGH LATE FRIDAY NIGHT.
- \* TIMING: SNOW AND SLEET WILL DEVELOP ACROSS THE AREA BY MIDDAY FRIDAY. THE PRECIPITATION WILL INTENSIFY AND TRANSITION TO FREEZING RAIN FRIDAY NIGHT. TEMPERATURES WILL WARM ABOVE FREEZING BY EARLY SATURDAY.
- \* MAIN IMPACT: A COMBINATION OF LIGHT SNOW AND SLEET ACCUMULATIONS UNDERNEATH A THIN LAYER OF ICE WILL CREATE A PERIOD OF VERY HAZARDOUS DRIVING CONDITIONS... ESPECIALLY FRIDAY EVENING. THERE IS SOME POTENTIAL FOR MORE SIGNIFICANT ICING OF ELEVATED OBJECTS. IF THAT OCCURS... SOME ISOLATED POWER OUTAGES COULD BECOME A PROBLEM.
- PRECAUTIONARY/PREPAREDNESS ACTIONS...
- A WINTER STORM WATCH MEANS THERE IS A POTENTIAL FOR SIGNIFICANT SNOW... SLEET... OR ICE ACCUMULATIONS THAT WOULD GREATLY IMPACT TRAVEL. STAY TUNED FOR LATER STATEMENTS. THIS WATCH WILL BE UPGRADED TO A WARNING IF WINTER STORM CONDITIONS BECOME MORE CERTAIN.

- ... ACTIVE WEATHER PATTERN TO CONTINUE THROUGH THE WEEKEND...
- SOUTH AND WEST OF A PERRYVILLE MISSOURI TO HOPKINSVILLE KENTUCKY LINE... MINOR ACCUMULATIONS OF SNOW UP TO 1 INCH WILL BE POSSIBLE LATE TONIGHT INTO FRIDAY. ISOLATED HIGHER

AMOUNTS CANNOT BE RULED OUT. ROADS THAT HAVE BEEN CLEARED MAY BECOME SLICK AGAIN AROUND THE MORNING COMMUTE TIME FRIDAY.

- VERY COLD WIND CHILL TEMPERATURES WILL BE POSSIBLE FRIDAY MORNING AS WELL ACROSS THE EVANSVILLE TRI STATE AREA DOWN INTO THE PENNYRILE REGION OF WEST KENTUCKY.
- LOOKING AHEAD... SOME MINOR ACCUMULATIONS OF ICE WILL BE POSSIBLE FRIDAY NIGHT... FOLLOWED BY PERIODS OF HEAVY RAIN INTO SATURDAY AND EARLY SATURDAY NIGHT THAT WILL LIKELY LEAD TO FLOODING CONCERNS GIVEN THE SNOW PACK ACROSS THE AREA.
- STAY TUNED FOR MORE UPDATES ON THIS ACTIVE PERIOD OF WEATHER THROUGH THE WEEKEND.

**Stoddard County, Missouri** - The National Weather Service in Paducah, Kentucky has issued a Wind Chill Advisory.

- ... WIND CHILL ADVISORY REMAINS IN EFFECT FROM 6 PM THIS EVENING TO NOON CST THURSDAY...
- A WIND CHILL ADVISORY REMAINS IN EFFECT FROM 6 PM THIS EVENING TO NOON CST THURSDAY.

- \* INCREDIBLY COLD ARCTIC AIR WITH RECORD SHATTERING LOW TEMPERATURES FORECAST WILL COMBINE WITH THE BRUTAL NORTH TO NORTHWEST WINDS BRINGING IT IN TO CREATE DANGEROUSLY COLD WIND CHILL READINGS TONIGHT.
- \* TIMING... TONIGHT THROUGH MIDDAY THURSDAY.
- \* WIND CHILL VALUES... BY SUNSET... BELOW ZERO. BY MIDNIGHT... 6 TO 18 BELOW ZERO. BY SUNRISE THURSDAY MORNING... 13 TO 24 BELOW ZERO.
- \* IMPACTS... FROSTBITE AND HYPOTHERMIA POSSIBLE WITH EXPOSURE IN AS LITTLE AS 30 MINUTES. BLOWING AND DRIFTING OF SNOW COVER POSSIBLE TOO DUE TO THE WINDS.
- PRECAUTIONARY/PREPAREDNESS ACTIONS...
- A WIND CHILL ADVISORY MEANS THAT VERY COLD AIR AND STRONG WINDS WILL COMBINE TO GENERATE WIND CHILLS OF 10 BELOW ZERO TO 25 BELOW ZERO. THIS WILL RESULT IN FROSTBITE AND LEAD TO HYPOTHERMIA IF PRECAUTIONS ARE NOT TAKEN. IF YOU MUST VENTURE OUTDOORS... MAKE SURE YOU WEAR A HAT AND GLOVES.

has issued a WINTER WEATHER ADVISORY for this afternoon.

- . WINTER WEATHER ADVISORY IN EFFECT FROM 4 PM THIS AFTERNOON TO 9 AM CST WEDNESDAY...
- THE NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE IN PADUCAH HAS ISSUED A WINTER WEATHER ADVISORY FOR SNOW... WHICH IS IN EFFECT FROM 4 PM THIS AFTERNOON TO 9 AM CST WEDNESDAY.
- \* TIMING: THE SNOW WILL MOVE WEST TO EAST ACROSS THE AREA AND PRODUCE 1 TO 2 INCHES OF NEW SNOWFALL FOR THE ENTIRE QUAD STATE REGION TONIGHT. THE SNOW WILL BEGIN IN SOUTHEAST MISSOURI AS EARLY AS LATE THIS AFTERNOON... THEN SWEEP EASTWARD ACROSS THE ENTIRE REGION TONIGHT.
- \* MAIN IMPACT: NEW SNOWFALL ON TOP OF ALREADY HEAVY SNOW ACCUMULATIONS WILL IMPACT MAINLY ROADS... PRODUCING A FRESH COATING ON TOP OF ALREADY CLEARED MAIN THOROUGHFARES AND ADDITIONAL SNOW ON TOP OF SECONDARY AND BACK ROADS.
- \* OTHER IMPACTS: SIDEWALKS AND DRIVEWAYS THAT HAVE BEEN CLEARED WILL RECEIVE ANOTHER LIGHT COATING OF SNOW TONIGHT. GUSTY WINDS 15 TO 25 MPH BEHIND THIS PASSING SYSTEM... WILL PRODUCE SOME BLOWING AND DRIFTING OF SNOW TOMORROW.
- PRECAUTIONARY/PREPAREDNESS ACTIONS...
- A WINTER WEATHER ADVISORY FOR SNOW MEANS THAT PERIODS OF SNOW WILL CAUSE PRIMARILY TRAVEL DIFFICULTIES. BE PREPARED FOR SNOW COVERED ROADS AND LIMITED VISIBILITIES... AND USE CAUTION WHILE DRIVING

**Stoddard County, Missouri** - The National Weather Service has issued a Special Weather Statement which includes below zero temperatures and more snow.

- .. A ROUND OF LIGHT SNOW LATE TODAY AND TONIGHT...
- A QUICK MOVING WEATHER SYSTEM SHOULD BRING AREAS ALONG AND SOUTH OF A PERRYVILLE MISSOURI TO OWENSBORO KENTUCKY LINE... UP TO 1 INCH OF NEW SNOW... WITH ISOLATED HIGHER AMOUNTS NEAR 2 INCHES IN SOME LOCATIONS NOT OUT



OF THE QUESTION... MAINLY BY THIS EVENING AND OVERNIGHT. SLIGHTLY LOWER AMOUNTS ARE ANTICIPATED FARTHER NORTH TOWARD INTERSTATE 64.

- WHILE GRADUAL IMPROVEMENTS ARE BEING MADE WITH PLOWING ACROSS THE AREA... MOST ROADS ARE STILL SNOW COVERED WITH SOME VERY HAZARDOUS TO NEAR IMPOSSIBLE TO DRIVE ON. USE EXTREME CAUTION IF YOU MUST GET OUT TO TRAVEL.
- QUICK LOOK AHEAD TO LATE WEDNESDAY NIGHT AND THURSDAY. IT WILL BE VERY COLD... WITH WIND CHILL TEMPERATURES PERHAPS 10 BELOW ZERO OR COLDER AT TIMES... WITH ACTUAL AIR TEMPERATURES FALLING BELOW ZERO. A WIND CHILL ADVISORY MAY BE REQUIRED FOR THIS TIME PERIOD.
