On September 25, 1948 he married Shirley Brown in Advance, Missouri.

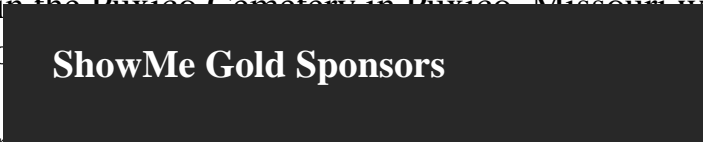
