Stoddard County, Missouri - The National Weather Service in Paducah, Kentucky has issued a special weather statement for Thursday.

SPECIAL WEATHER STATEMENT UNTIL 4PM CST THU

...LIGHT SNOWS POSSIBLE SATURDAY INTO SATURDAY EVENING

... MUCH COLDER CANADIAN AIR WILL BE MOVING INTO THE AREA LATE THIS WEEK INTO THE WEEKEND. AT THE SAME TIME, AN UPPER LEVEL DISTURBANCE WILL DROP SOUTHEASTWARD INTO THE REGION, BRINGING A GOOD CHANCE OF SOME LIGHT RAIN AND SNOW TO MUCH OF THE REGION. RELATIVELY WARM ANTECEDENT CONDITIONS AND TEMPERATURES HOVERING AROUND OR JUST ABOVE FREEZING WOULD LIKELY MINIMIZE TRAVEL IMPACTS, ESPECIALLY DURING THE DAYLIGHT HOURS.

HOWEVER, IF SNOW COMES DOWN HARD AT TIMES, OR IF SNOW LASTS MUCH PAST SUNSET WHEN TEMPERATURES FALL INTO THE 20S, THERE COULD BE SOME IMPACTS, ESPECIALLY ON ELEVATED ROADWAYS. ALL PRECIPITATION SHOULD EXIT THE REGION BY MIDNIGHT.

SPECIAL WEATHER STATEMENT UNTIL 1AM CST TUE

**...OCCASIONAL WIND GUSTS BETWEEN 35 AND 50 MPH LIKELY AHEAD
OF THUNDERSTORMS LATER TONIGHT**

... AT 1030 PM CST, THE CURRENT LINE OF THUNDERSTORMS

PROMPTING SEVERAL WARNINGS ACROSS MISSOURI STRETCHES FROM THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF MISSOURI TO THE SOUTHWEST CORNER. AS SHOWERS CONTINUE TO DEVELOP AND MOVE ACROSS THE AREA THROUGH MIDNIGHT. WIND GUSTS BETWEEN 35 AND 45 MPH WILL BE LIKELY.

THESE STRONG WIND GUSTS WILL CONTINUE TO EXPAND ACROSS SOUTHERN ILLINOIS, REACHING ACROSS THE OHIO AND WABASH RIVERS INTO SOUTHWEST INDIANA AND WEST KENTUCKY BETWEEN 11 PM AND 1 AM CST. WIND GUSTS MAY EVEN APPROACH 50 MPH OVER PARTS OF SOUTHERN ILLINOIS AND SOUTHEAST MISSOURI NEAR OR AFTER MIDNIGHT, ALONG AND AHEAD OF DEVELOPING THUNDERSTORMS.

SPECIAL WEATHER STATEMENT UNTIL 11PM CST MON

...OCCASIONAL WIND GUSTS BETWEEN 35 AND 50 MPH POSSIBLE AHEAD OF THUNDERSTORMS LATER TONIGHT

... ALTHOUGH THE CURRENT LINE OF THUNDERSTORMS REMAINS WELL

TO THE WEST, APPROACHING NORTHWEST MISSOURI AS OF 5 PM CST, GUSTY SOUTH TO SOUTHWEST WINDS ARE EXPECTED TO INCREASE THROUGHOUT THE EVENING AND THROUGH THE MIDNIGHT HOUR ACROSS THE QUAD STATE REGION. STRONG WIND GUSTS IN EXCESS OF 35 MPH WILL LIKELY DEVELOP OVER SOUTHWEST ILLINOIS, WEST OF INTERSTATE 57 AND NORTH OF ROUTE 13 IN SOUTHERN ILLINOIS BETWEEN 7 PM AND 8 PM CST. THESE WIND GUSTS WILL GRADUALLY EXPAND ACROSS SOUTHERN ILLINOIS, REACHING ACROSS THE OHIO AND WABASH RIVERS INTO SOUTHWEST INDIANA AND WEST KENTUCKY

BETWEEN 10 PM AND 11 PM CST. WIND GUSTS MAY EVEN APPROACH 50 MPH OVER PARTS OF SOUTHERN ILLINOIS AND SOUTHEAST MISSOURI AROUND OR SHORTLY AFTER MIDNIGHT.

IF YOU ARE TRAVELING TONIGHT, BE PREPARED FOR GUSTY WINDS THAT MAY CAUSE ISSUES FOR CONTROLLING YOUR VEHICLE.

Stoddard County, Missouri - The National Weather Service in Paducah, KY has issued a Severe Thunderstorm Warning for Stoddard and Butler Counties.

**THE NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE IN PADUCAH HAS ISSUED A *

... CENTRAL BUTLER COUNTY IN SOUTHEASTERN MISSOURI

... SOUTHWESTERN STODDARD COUNTY IN SOUTHEASTERN MISSOURI

... * UNTIL 430 AM CST * AT 404 AM CST, A SEVERE THUNDERSTORM WAS LOCATED NEAR HARVIELL, OR NEAR POPLAR BLUFF, MOVING EAST AT 55 MPH. HAZARD

... 60 MPH WIND GUSTS AND QUARTER SIZE HAIL. SOURCE... RADAR INDICATED. IMPACT... HAIL DAMAGE TO VEHICLES IS EXPECTED. EXPECT WIND DAMAGE TO ROOFS, SIDING, AND TREES. *

LOCATIONS IMPACTED INCLUDE... POPLAR BLUFF, DEXTER, BERNIE, NEELYVILLE, QULIN, FISK, DUDLEY AND HARVIELL.

PRECAUTIONARY/PREPAREDNESS ACTIONS... A TORNADO WATCH REMAINS IN EFFECT FOR THE WARNED AREA. TORNADOES CAN DEVELOP QUICKLY FROM SEVERE THUNDERSTORMS. ALTHOUGH A TORNADO IS NOT IMMEDIATELY LIKELY, IF ONE IS SPOTTED, ACT QUICKLY AND MOVE TO A PLACE OF SAFETY INSIDE A STURDY STRUCTURE SUCH AS A BASEMENT OR SMALL INTERIOR ROOM.

FOR YOUR PROTECTION MOVE TO AN INTERIOR ROOM ON THE LOWEST FLOOR OF A BUILDING. && A TORNADO WATCH REMAINS IN EFFECT UNTIL 800 AM CST FOR SOUTHEASTERN MISSOURI. A TORNADO WATCH ALSO REMAINS IN EFFECT UNTIL 800 AM CST FOR SOUTHEASTERN MISSOURI. HAIL... 1.00IN WIND... 60MPH


