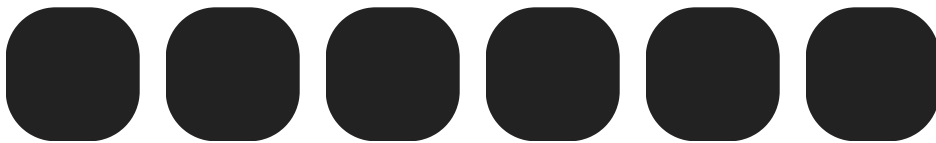
Stoddard County, Missouri - Severe Thunderstorm Warning issued for Northeast Stoddard County until 4:30 p.m.

# Special Weather Statement Until 4 a.m. Sunday

## Special Weather Statement Until 4 a.m. Sunday

Stoddard County, Missouri - The National Weather Service has issued a Special Weather Statement until 4 a.m. Sunday.

### SPECIAL WEATHER STATEMENT UNTIL 4AM CDT SUN

...AFTERNOON HEAT INDICES 100 TO 105 DEGREES SUNDAY AND MONDAY

... HIGH PRESSURE ALOFT WILL BUILD OVER THE REGION THROUGH MONDAY. THIS WILL LEAD TO INCREASING HEAT AND HUMIDITY ACROSS THE QUAD STATE REGION. SOUTHEAST MISSOURI AND SOUTHERN ILLINOIS WILL EXPERIENCE THE WORST CONDITIONS WITH HEAT INDEX VALUES TOPPING OUT FROM 100 TO 105 DEGREES EACH AFTERNOON.

ISOLATED SHOWERS AND THUNDERSTORMS MAY PROVIDE SOME RELIEF FOR A FEW LOCATIONS, BUT MOST OF THIS REGION WILL REMAIN DRY BOTH DAYS. ELSEWHERE, ACROSS SOUTHWEST INDIANA AND WEST KENTUCKY HEAT INDEX VALUES WILL TOP OUT FROM 95 TO 100 DEGREES EACH AFTERNOON. WITH LARGE NUMBERS OF PEOPLE EXPECTED TO BE OUTDOORS SUNDAY THROUGH MONDAY, THE POTENTIAL FOR HEAT RELATED ILLNESS MAY INCREASE, ESPECIALLY FOR THOSE NOT ACCUSTOMED TO THE TYPICAL HEAT AND HUMIDITY OF LATE AUGUST. BE SURE TO DRINK PLENTY OF WATER AND FIND OPPORTUNITIES TO KEEP COOL IN THE SHADE, WHEN POSSIBLE. THE HEAT SHOULD MOVE OUT OF THE AREA LATER ON TUESDAY, AS SHOWERS AND THUNDERSTORMS USHER IN COOLER AIR FOR THE MIDDLE OF NEXT WEEK.

### Special Weather Statement Issued Until 6 p.m. Sunday

Stoddard County, Missouri - The National Weather Service in Paducah, Kentucky has issued a Special Weather Statement until 6 p.m. Sunday.

**SPECIAL WEATHER STATEMENT UNTIL 6PM CDT SUN**

**...GUSTY WINDS AND LOCALLY HEAVY RAINFALL POSSIBLE WITH THUNDERSTORMS THIS AFTERNOON AND THIS EVENING**

**... AN AREA OF SURFACE LOW PRESSURE, ALONG WITH AN UPPER LEVEL DISTURBANCE IN NORTHERN ARKANSAS, WILL MOVE ACROSS THE DELTA REGION OF SOUTHEAST MISSOURI THIS AFTERNOON.**

**THIS AREA OF LOW PRESSURE WILL THEN MOVE ACROSS PARTS OF SOUTHERN PURCHASE AND PENNYRILE REGIONS OF WEST KENTUCKY LATE THIS AFTERNOON AND EARLY THIS EVENING. SOME OF THE THUNDERSTORMS THAT DEVELOP IN THIS AREA MAY BE CAPABLE OF**

PRODUCING LOCAL WIND GUSTS IN EXCESS OF 40 MPH OR HIGHER, AS WELL AS HEAVY RAINFALL NEAR AN INCH AN HOUR.

THE GUSTY WINDS MAY TOSS AROUND LOOSE OBJECTS OUTDOORS, BREAK TREE LIMBS, OR DOWN SMALL OR WEAKENED TREES. THE HEAVY RAIN MAY CAUSE QUICK RISES OF DITCHES, CREEKS, AND STREAMS TO BANKFULL, AS WELL AS CAUSE MINOR FLOODING OF LOW-LYING AREAS AND ROADWAYS. THE MAIN AREA OF CONCERN FOR STRONGER THUNDERSTORMS IS ALONG AND SOUTH OF A SIKESTON MISSOURI, CALVERT CITY AND GREENVILLE KENTUCKY LINE.

HOWEVER, ISOLATED STRONG WIND GUSTS MAY BE POSSIBLE AS FAR NORTH AS SCOTT CITY MISSOURI, PADUCAH AND MADISONVILLE KENTUCKY THIS AFTERNOON AND TONIGHT. THE THUNDERSTORM ACTIVITY SHOULD DIMINISH MARKEDLY DURING THE LATE EVENING AND OVERNIGHT HOURS.

**SPECIAL WEATHER STATEMENT UNTIL 6PM CDT WED**

**...A FEW STORMS MAY PRODUCE SMALL HAIL AND GUSTY WINDS THIS AFTERNOON**

**... AS THE AFTERNOON PROGRESSES, A FEW STORMS ACROSS PARTS OF SOUTHERN ILLINOIS, WEST KENTUCKY, SOUTHWEST INDIANA, AND SOUTHEAST MISSOURI MAY PRODUCE HAIL RANGING FROM ONE QUARTER OF AN INCH TO JUST LESS THAN AN INCH IN SIZE, AS WELL AS ISOLATED WIND GUSTS BETWEEN 40 AND 50 MPH.**

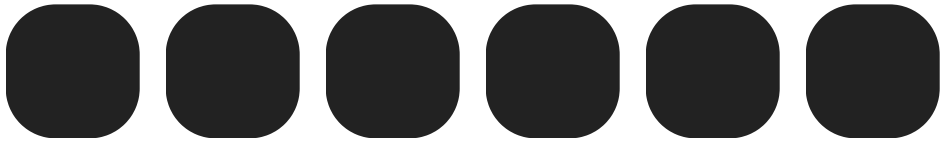
**THE BEST CHANCES OF SEEING STRONGER STORMS WILL BE ALONG AND NORTH OF A LINE FROM POPLAR BLUFF MISSOURI, ONWARD TO EDDYVILLE ILLINOIS AND GREENVILLE KENTUCKY.**

**IN ADDITION TO THE HAIL AND WIND GUSTS, BRIEF HEAVY RAIN AND LIGHTNING CAN BE EXPECTED.**

**THE POTENTIAL FOR HAIL AND GUSTY WINDS SHOULD DIMINISH MARKEDLY AFTER 600 PM CDT**
