ISOLATED GUSTS ABOVE 40 MPH ARE POSSIBLE, ESPECIALLY WHERE CLOUD COVER THINS OUT.

WINDS ARE EXPECTED TO DIMINISH SOMEWHAT AFTER NIGHTFALL, BUT WILL STILL REMAIN GUSTY. EXPECT THESE STRONG WINDS TO

IMPACT AREA TRAVEL AND OUTDOOR WORK, SO BE ADVISED, ESPECIALLY IF DRIVING A HIGH PROFILE VEHICLE.

... WINDS WILL AVERAGE 15 TO 30 MPH OUT OF THE SOUTH OR SOUTHWEST, AND GUSTS WILL FOR THE MOST PART, BE IN THE 30 TO 40 MPH RANGE, FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE DAY.

HOWEVER, THERE MAY BE AN ISOLATED EXCEPTION OR TWO, WHERE A GUST COULD BE AS HIGH AS 45 MPH OR MORE.

THIS WILL OCCUR WHERE THE CLOUDS BREAK TO FULL SUNSHINE, AND SHOULD BE AN INSTANTANEOUS OR SHORT LIVED GUST THAT AVERAGES ABOUT 10 MPH HIGHER THAN MOST GUSTS.

THESE STRONG WINDS AND GUSTS WILL CONTINUE INTO EARLY THIS EVENING, BEFORE DIMINISHING OFF THEIR PEAKS WITH THE SETTING SUN. EXPECT THESE STRONG WINDS TO IMPACT AREA TRAVEL AND OUTDOOR WORK, SO BE ADVISED, ESPECIALLY IF DRIVING A HIGH PROFILE VEHICLE.
