## SPECIAL WEATHER STATEMENT UNTIL 7PM CST THU

...STRONG GUSTY WINDS CONTINUE UNTIL NIGHTFALL

... WINDS WILL AVERAGE 15 TO 30 MPH OUT OF THE SOUTH OR SOUTHWEST, AND GUSTS WILL FOR THE MOST PART, BE IN THE 30 TO 40 MPH RANGE, FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE DAY.

HOWEVER, THERE MAY BE AN ISOLATED EXCEPTION OR TWO, WHERE A GUST COULD BE AS HIGH AS 45 MPH OR MORE.

THIS WILL OCCUR WHERE THE CLOUDS BREAK TO FULL SUNSHINE, AND SHOULD BE AN INSTANTANEOUS OR SHORT LIVED GUST THAT AVERAGES ABOUT 10 MPH HIGHER THAN MOST GUSTS.

THESE STRONG WINDS AND GUSTS WILL CONTINUE INTO EARLY THIS EVENING, BEFORE DIMINISHING OFF THEIR PEAKS WITH THE SETTING SUN. EXPECT THESE STRONG WINDS TO IMPACT AREA TRAVEL AND OUTDOOR WORK, SO BE ADVISED, ESPECIALLY IF DRIVING A HIGH PROFILE VEHICLE. MOBILE HOMES AND CONSTRUCTION SITES WILL FEEL THE IMPACT OF THESE WINDS AND GUSTS. **SPECIAL WEATHER STATEMENT UNTIL 9PM CST SUN**

**...A LIGHT WINTRY MIX OF PRECIPITATION POSSIBLE THIS EVENING**



... RADAR RETURNS CONTINUE TO TAKE SHAPE ACROSS SOUTHEAST MISSOURI, FAR SOUTHERN ILLINOIS, SOUTHWEST INDIANA AND WESTERN KENTUCKY.

WE NOW BELIEVE A VERY LIGHT WINTRY MIX OF PRECIPITATION WILL CONTINUE TO EXPAND EAST ACROSS THIS REGION EARLY TONIGHT. THERE IS STILL SOME UNCERTAINTY WITH THIS EVENT.

PRECIPITATION AMOUNTS SHOULD REMAIN LIGHT IF THE ACTIVITY REALLY GETS GOING. HOWEVER, WITH TEMPERATURES BELOW FREEZING, ANY LIGHT ACCUMULATION OF FREEZING RAIN OR SLEET COULD RESULT IN THE DEVELOPMENT SLICK SPOTS ON AREA ROADS, BRIDGES AND OVERPASSES, INCLUDING UNTREATED ROAD SURFACES.

WE MAY SEE ALL FORMS OF PRECIPITATION, INCLUDING LIGHT SLEET, LIGHT FREEZING RAIN AND DRIZZLE, AND LIGHT SNOW. SHOULD IMPACTS BECOME MORE PROMINENT, AN UPGRADE TO A WINTER WEATHER ADVISORY MAY BE REQUIRED.

... RADAR RETURNS ARE TAKING SHAPE ACROSS SOUTHEAST MISSOURI.

WE THINK THERE WILL BE A CHANCE OF A WINTRY MIX OF  
PRECIPITATION THAT WILL EXPAND EAST INTO WEST KENTUCKY,  
POSSIBLY CLIPPING PORTIONS OF THE SOUTHERN TIP OF ILLINOIS AND  
PART OF SOUTHWEST INDIANA AS WELL AS WE HEAD INTO THE  
EVENING HOURS.

THERE IS STILL SOME UNCERTAINTY WITH THIS EVENT. PRECIPITATION  
AMOUNTS SHOULD REMAIN LIGHT IF THE ACTIVITY REALLY GETS  
GOING. HOWEVER, WITH TEMPERATURES BELOW FREEZING, ANY LIGHT  
ACCUMULATION COULD RESULT IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF SLICK  
SPOTS ON AREA ROADS, BRIDGES AND OVERPASSES, INCLUDING

**...ICE STORM WARNING IN EFFECT UNTIL 6 AM CST WEDNESDAY**

... \* WHAT...SIGNIFICANT ICING EXPECTED. TOTAL ICE ACCUMULATIONS OF TWO TENTHS TO THREE TENTHS OF AN INCH ARE EXPECTED. SOME SLEET IS POSSIBLE AS WELL.

\* WHERE...IN MISSOURI, RIPLEY, BUTLER, STODDARD AND SCOTT COUNTIES. IN ILLINOIS, ALEXANDER COUNTY. \* WHEN...UNTIL 6 AM CST WEDNESDAY. \* ADDITIONAL DETAILS

...ISOLATED POWER OUTAGES AND TREE DAMAGE ARE LIKELY DUE TO THE ICE.

TRAVEL WILL BE DANGEROUS. WINDS WILL INCREASE TO AROUND 15 MPH TOWARD SUNRISE, WHICH COULD HELP TO BRING DOWN ICE-LADEN BRANCHES. PRECAUTIONARY/PREPAREDNESS ACTIONS

... AN ICE STORM WARNING MEANS SIGNIFICANT AMOUNTS OF ICE ACCUMULATION WILL MAKE TRAVEL DANGEROUS. TRAVEL IS STRONGLY DISCOURAGED.

IF YOU MUST TRAVEL, KEEP AN EXTRA FLASHLIGHT, FOOD AND WATER IN YOUR VEHICLE IN CASE OF AN EMERGENCY. SNAPPED POWER LINES AND FALLING TREE BRANCHES ARE ALSO POSSIBLE. THE LATEST ROAD CONDITIONS FOR THE STATE YOU ARE CALLING FROM CAN BE OBTAINED BY CALLING 5 1 1. &&
