**... AT 100 PM CDT, DOPPLER RADAR WAS TRACKING STRONG**

THUNDERSTORMS ALONG A LINE EXTENDING FROM NEAR BOLLINGER MILL STATE HISTORIC SITE TO SUCCESS. THESE STORMS WERE NEARLY STATIONARY.

HALF INCH HAIL AND WINDS IN EXCESS OF 40 MPH WILL BE POSSIBLE WITH THESE STORMS. LOCATIONS IMPACTED INCLUDE... CAPE GIRARDEAU, POPLAR BLUFF, JACKSON, DEXTER, DONIPHAN, PIEDMONT, BERNIE, BLOOMFIELD, MARBLE HILL, ADVANCE, VAN BUREN, BOLLINGER MILL STATE HISTORIC SITE, GREENVILLE, TRAIL OF TEARS STATE PARK, LAKE WAPPAPELLO STATE PARK, SAM A. PRECAUTIONARY/PREPAREDNESS ACTIONS

... TORRENTIAL RAINFALL IS ALSO OCCURRING WITH THESE STORMS, AND MAY LEAD TO LOCALIZED FLOODING.

DO NOT DRIVE YOUR VEHICLE THROUGH FLOODED ROADWAYS.

FREQUENT CLOUD TO GROUND LIGHTNING IS OCCURRING WITH THESE STORMS. LIGHTNING CAN STRIKE 10 MILES AWAY FROM A THUNDERSTORM. SEEK A SAFE SHELTER INSIDE A BUILDING OR VEHICLE.

HEAT ADVISORY FROM 11AM CDT FRI UNTIL 7PM CDT FRI

...HEAT ADVISORY IN EFFECT FROM 11 AM TO 7 PM CDT FRIDAY

... THE NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE IN PADUCAH HAS ISSUED A HEAT ADVISORY, WHICH IS IN EFFECT FROM 11 AM TO 7 PM CDT FRIDAY.

THIS HEAT ADVISORY INCLUDES PARTS OF SOUTHEAST MISSOURI AND EXTREME WESTERN KENTUCKY, SOUTHWEST OF A LINE FROM CAPE GIRARDEAU TO PADUCAH. \* TEMPERATURE...HIGH TEMPERATURES WILL BE IN THE LOWER TO MID 90S. THE HEAT INDEX WILL PEAK BETWEEN 104 AND 108 DEGREES IN THE AFTERNOON. \* IMPACTS

...PERSONS WORKING OUTDOORS OR ENGAGING IN RECREATIONAL ACTIVITIES WILL ENCOUNTER HAZARDOUS LEVELS OF HEAT AND HUMIDITY. PRECAUTIONARY/PREPAREDNESS ACTIONS

**...MORE HEAT AND HUMIDITY EXPECTED TODAY**

... AFTER A BREAK IN THE HEAT YESTERDAY DUE TO EXTENSIVE CLOUDS AND THUNDERSTORM ACTIVITY, THE UNCOMFORTABLE HEAT AND HUMIDITY LEVELS WILL RETURN TO MUCH OF THE REGION TODAY.

AFTERNOON TEMPERATURES FROM NEAR 90 TO THE MID 90S WILL COMBINE WITH THE HUMID CONDITIONS TO PRODUCE HEAT INDEX VALUES FROM 97 TO 105 THE VERY YOUNG, THE ELDERLY, THOSE WITHOUT AIR CONDITIONING, AND THOSE PARTICIPATING IN STRENUOUS OUTDOOR ACTIVITIES WILL BE THE MOST SUSCEPTIBLE TO THE HEAT.

HUMIDITY EXPECTED TODAY AND MONDAY.

.. VERY UNCOMFORTABLE HUMIDITY LEVELS WILL COMBINE WITH AFTERNOON TEMPERATURES IN THE UPPER 80S AND LOWER 90S TO PRODUCE HEAT INDEX VALUES IN THE 100 TO 105 RANGE IN BEWEEN ANY AREAS OF THUNDERSTORMS TODAY AND MONDAY.

... THE NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE IN PADUCAH HAS ISSUED A HEAT ADVISORY, WHICH IS IN EFFECT FROM 10 AM THIS MORNING TO 8 PM CDT THIS EVENING.

\* HEAT INDEX...HIGH TEMPERATURES IN THE MID 90S COUPLED WITH HIGH HUMIDITY WILL RESULT IN PEAK HEAT INDEX READINGS FROM 105 TO 110 THIS AFTERNOON. \* IMPACTS

...THE COMBINATION OF HEAT AND HUMIDITY WILL LEAD TO AN INCREASED RISK OF HEAT-RELATED STRESS AND ILLNESS. THE VERY YOUNG, THE ELDERLY, THOSE WITHOUT AIR CONDITIONING, AND THOSE PARTICIPATING IN STRENUOUS OUTDOOR ACTIVITIES WILL BE THE MOST SUSCEPTIBLE. ALSO, CAR INTERIORS CAN REACH LETHAL TEMPERATURES IN A MATTER OF MINUTES.

PRECAUTIONARY/PREPAREDNESS ACTIONS

... TAKE EXTRA PRECAUTIONS IF YOU WORK OR SPEND TIME OUTSIDE. WHEN POSSIBLE, RESCHEDULE STRENUOUS ACTIVITIES TO EARLY MORNING OR EVENING. WEAR LIGHT WEIGHT AND LOOSE FITTING CLOTHING WHEN POSSIBLE AND DRINK PLENTY OF WATER.

TAKE FREQUENT REST BREAKS IN SHADED OR AIR CONDITIONED ENVIRONMENTS. ANYONE OVERCOME BY HEAT SHOULD BE MOVED TO A COOL AND SHADED LOCATION. KNOW THE SIGNS AND SYMPTOMS OF HEAT EXHAUSTION AND HEAT STROKE.

HEAT STROKE IS AN EMERGENCY. CALL 9 1 1 FOR ANYONE SHOWING SYMPTOMS.

YOUNG CHILDREN AND PETS SHOULD NEVER BE LEFT UNATTENDED IN VEHICLES UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES.

THIS IS ESPECIALLY TRUE DURING HOT WEATHER WHEN CAR INTERIORS CAN REACH LETHAL TEMPERATURES IN A MATTER OF MINUTES. REMEMBER TO LOOK BEFORE YOU LOCK.
