Puxico Falls Short to Woodland 5-0

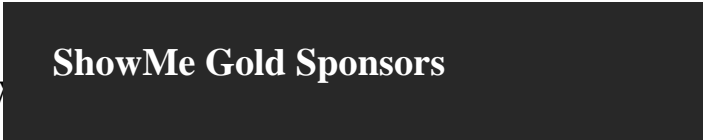
