Interment will be in the Parma Cemetery in Parma, Missouri with full Military Honors.

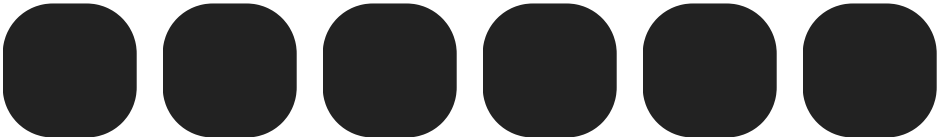
