Stephenson To Serve On National Board

POPLAR BLUFF, MO – Three Rivers College president Dr. Devin Stephenson has been invited to serve as a commissioner with the American Association of Community Colleges (AACC).

AACC Commissions advise the Board of Directors on issues that "reflect key aspects of the Association's work on behalf of its member colleges." Stephenson has been asked to serve on the Commission of Communications and Marketing.
