"McKenzie had a good game this evening," Hutchcraft continued. "She is a great server and that showed tonight, especially in the first set with five aces! I can always count on her to really attack the ball when she's on front row, too, which will be crucial tomorrow night against Notre Dame."

The Lady 'Cats will face district rival - and a major volleyball powerhouse for the last decade - Notre Dame tomorrow night during the SEMO Tournament, held in both the ShowMe Center and the Notre Dame High School gym. This matchup will be a great 'preview' game for the 'Cats, as they usually don't get to face the Lady Bulldogs until the week before districts.

The 'Cats will have 'pool play' games Friday evening and Saturday morning, with the tournament bracket kicking off Saturday afternoon.

"The top team from each pool will advance to the Gold bracket; the second team will go to the Silver; and the third team will go to the Bronze," Hutchcraft said. "The SEMO Tournament will be a good tournament for anyone wanting to watch some good volleyball in the area!"
