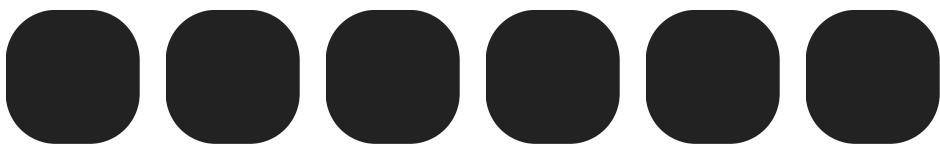
Kelvin Wooten was born on October 1, 1968 and died on January 25, 2012 at the age of 43.

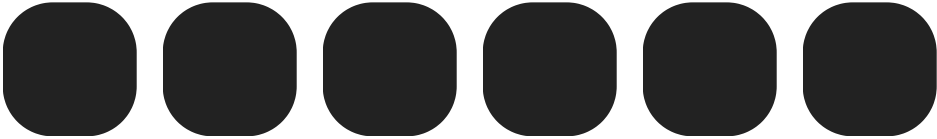
Besides her husband and parents two brothers, Howard Davis and Donald Davis, preceded her in death.
