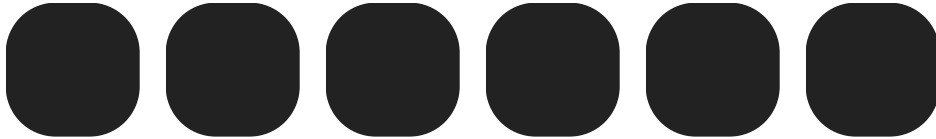

On December 3, 1949, she was married to Floyd Nichols in Piggott, Ark. He preceded her in death on December 24, 2009.

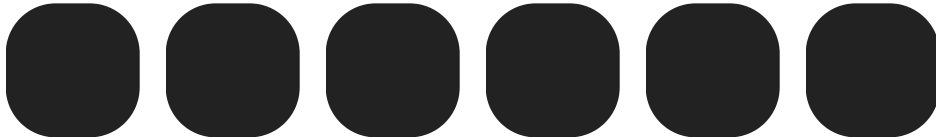

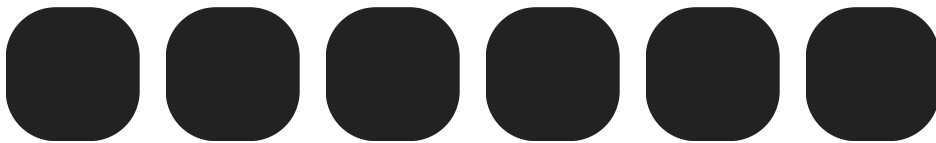
