Middle School 'Cats Run-Rule Charleston

The Blue Jays were three up, three down in the fourth inning; the Bearcats exploded for seven more runs to take an 18-2 lead. Charleston was unable to put anything together in the top of the fifth, ending the game due to the 10 run rule.

The Bearcats are scheduled to be back in action on Thursday (April 21) afternoon when

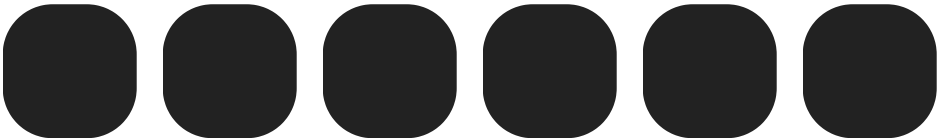
they host the Campbell Camels. First pitch is scheduled for 4:00 p.m.
