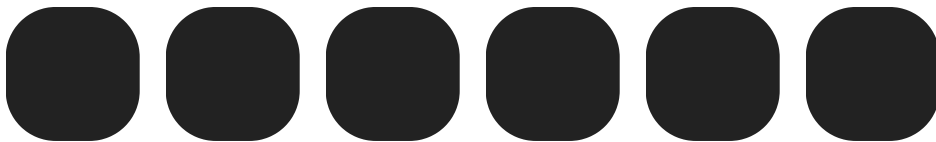
Robert Edwards of Essex, Missouri passed away at his home in Essex on April 12, 2012.

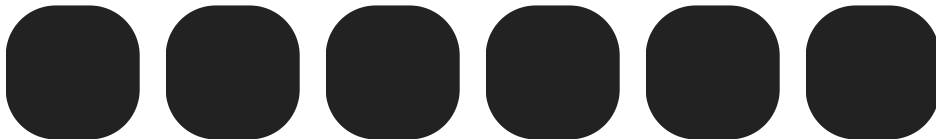

He was preceded in death by three brothers, Jackie Oswald, George Oswald and Charles White.

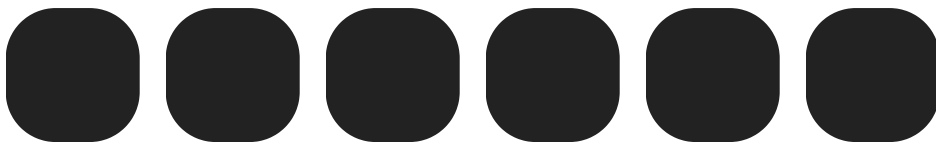
Memorial services will be held at 1p.m., Saturday, April 14, 2012, at the Gideon Baptist Church in Gideon, Missouri.

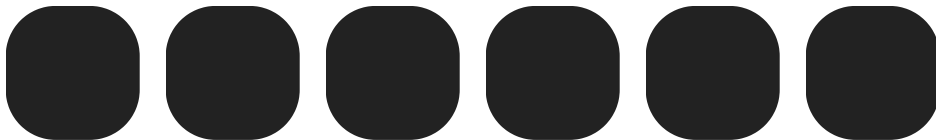

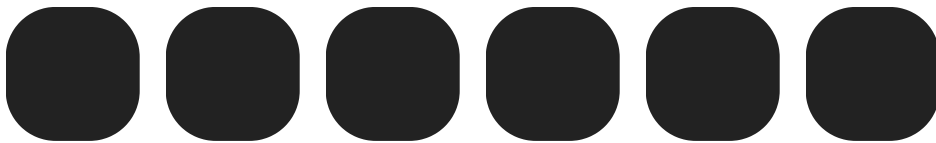
