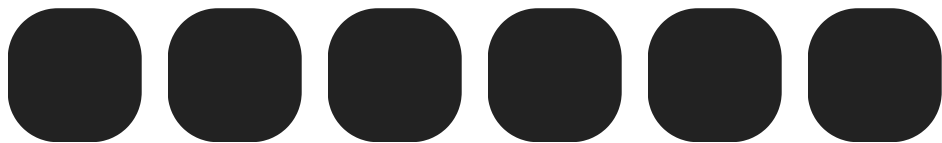

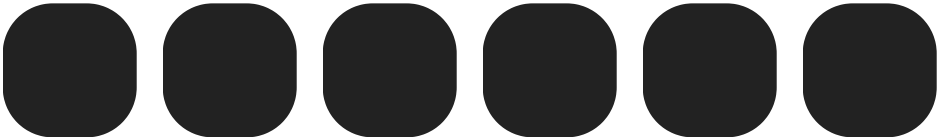
Visitation will be held on Friday, July 6, 2012, from 5:00 to 8:00 p.m. at Watkins and Sons Funeral Home in Dexter.
