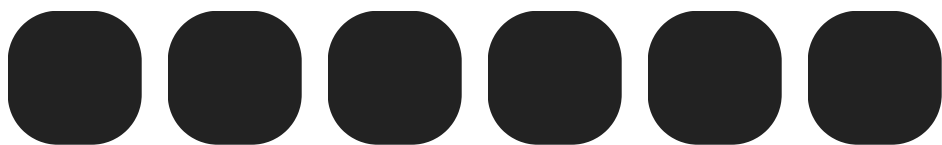

The Black Team vs the Green Team was a unique defensive battle with neither team able to reach the endzone for a score. The game ended with a score of 0 to 0.

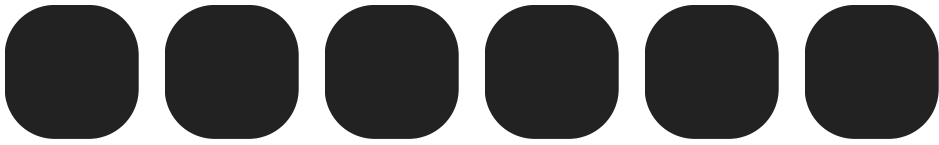
