
It will be a very competitive year for the Bearcats, but this team has proved through many practices that they will fight hard for victories.

After two more Harris buckets Notre Dame got on the board with two free throws by Kristina Eason. The Lady Cats then went on a 12-0 run featuring baskets by Mollie Whitehead, Erika Cobb (12 points on the night) and Paige Patterson, who finished with 13 points and 10 rebounds for the game. Dexter continued to force turnovers and ended up with a 44-12 halftime lead.

The second half was more of the same with the defense forcing 10 turnovers in the third quarter. Patterson and Cobb lead the scoring charge. The fourth quarter featured a running "mercy" and gave the final score of 70-34.

Bernie Mules Start Season with Victory




