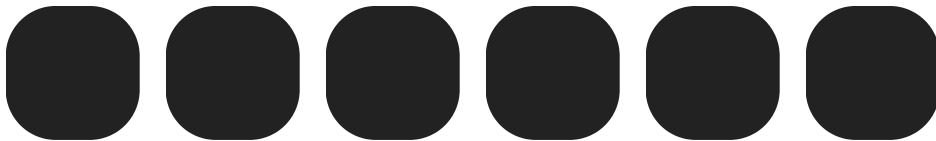

To date, 18 FORE Life has given away just under \$900,000 in love offerings with plans to break the \$1 million mark this year!

The 7th and 8th grade Lady 'Cats Volleyball Team is proud to host the Hits for Hope game and with the community's support they promise to continue this game annually. **They raised an amazing \$6,500 during the Hits for Hope event!** Truly inspiring!
