Way to go DHS Lady 'Cats on your record of 12 - 3 this season.

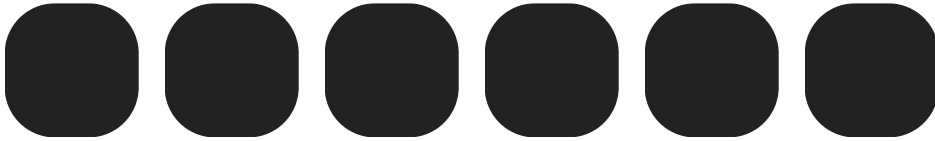
The Lady 'Cats played Scott City on Tuesday night winning both of their matches.
