hurt his receiving numbers a bit," commented Coach Justin Peden. "He is an excellent player and the most deserving player I have."

Parents may order shirts as well. Payment is required at time of sign-up.

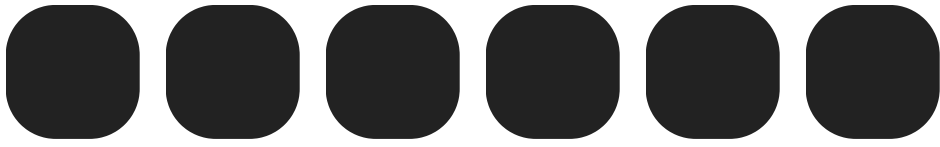
Let's support these youngsters and get them started in a great sport!

Good luck Bearcats and we can't wait to see you on the court! What an exciting year this is going to be. Go Bearcats!

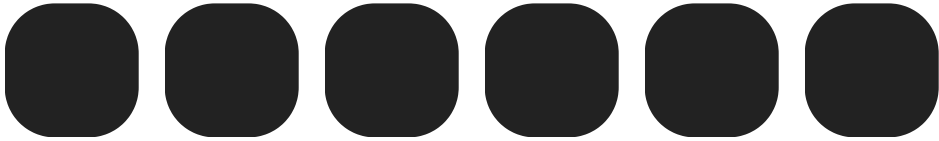
