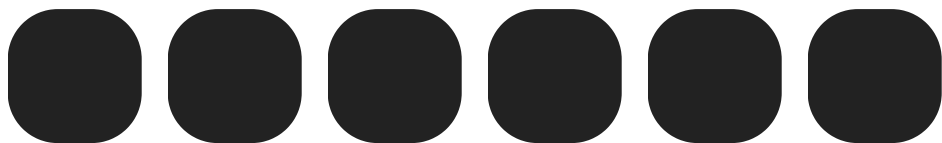

It's a scrimmage! Mule vs Mule. Game time is 6:00 p.m.

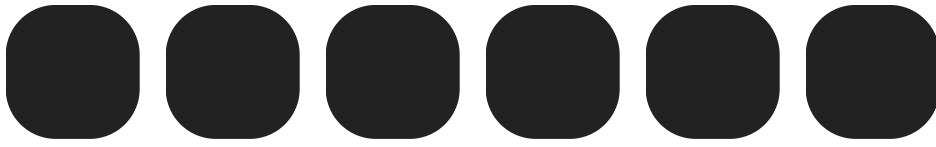
