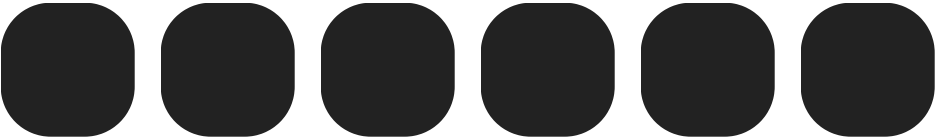
Interment will follow in the Ash Hill Cemetery at Fisk.
