Other relatives and many friends also survive. She was preceded in death by her twin sister, Reatha Putnam, two other sisters and seven brothers.

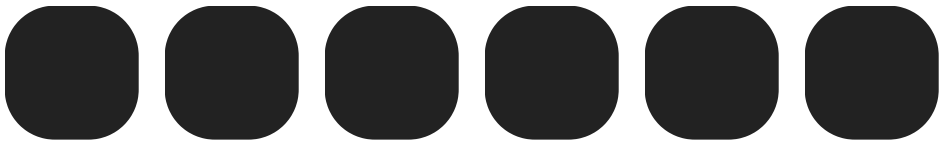
Private family services will be held with Rev. Donnie Emmons of Poplar Bluff, Missouri officiating.
