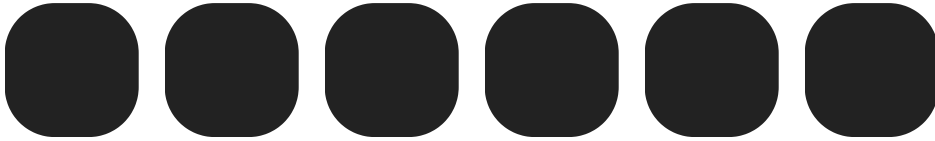
An individual from Kentucky recently contacted City Administrator Mark Stidham asking for information as to whether the home is still standing.

Girls State/Boys State Attendance

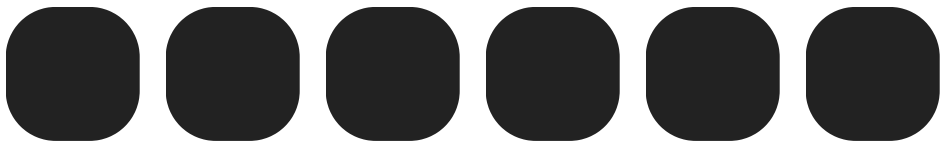
