Application Deadline Extended for RN Program

Poplar Bluff, Missouri - Three Rivers College's Department of Nursing and Allied Health has extended the application deadline for its day and evening Registered Nurse program in Poplar Bluff to March 17th at 5 p.m.

"Our first concern was the time lost to weather closings this winter and making sure that we gave our applicants time to catch up from that," said Staci Campbell, Chair of the Department of Nursing and Allied Health. "This is also our first application cycle with our increased prerequisites, and we wanted to allow students to complete their pre-requisite courses of Intermediate Algebra and Introductory Chemistry in the summer 2014 session."

Applicants for the Nursing programs must be enrolled in or have passed MATH 103 or 153, have completed or be enrolled in CHEM 111, take the NLN-PAX-RN pre-entrance exam and achieve a minimum score of 105, and have a minimum 2.5 GPA across all college credit hours completed to be eligible for admission into the programs.

Campbell advises that all admissions materials, including official copies of transcripts from high school and other colleges, must be received by the March 17 deadline. Application forms for the RN program can be found online by going

to trcc.edu/admissions and clicking on "Applications." Prospective students must also complete a free Three Rivers application. For more information, contact Staci Campbell at 573-840-9680.





Essex, Missouri - As the deadline for FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) approaches on March 1st, the Richland R-1 School District will be holding a free FAFSA night workshop for all seniors and parents who wish to attend. This event will be held on Thursday, February 27th, at 6pm in the High School Computer Lab. Please be sure to bring your Federal 2013 or 2012 tax returns! A college representative will be at the FAFSA night to help guide the parents and students through filling out the FAFSA.

Be sure to mark your calendars if you plan to attend. Parents and students will need to attend together. If there are any questions, please contact the Richland High School Counselor, Mrs. Hampton. If students are set up on the Remind Me Texting App, there are multiple reminders being sent out, as well as pin number information for the event. You can setup the pin number online at http://pin.ed.gov and just follow the instructions on the website. If there is any trouble using the link that was sent through the message, please see Mrs. Hampton in her office sometime this week.

On top of the upcoming FAFSA night, there are also multiple scholarships that have quickly approaching deadlines. If a senior has already been accepted by a college, the college should have many endowment scholarships that they could be rewarded. So don't miss out! Southeast Missouri State University, Arkansas State University, and Missouri State University Endowment Scholarships have a deadline of March 1st. The Three Rivers College Endowment Scholarship is on April 1st. Students that have been accepted to these colleges are eligible to apply for these scholarships online.

Here are more scholarship deadlines (all scholarship forms are placed in senior mailboxes):

Southeast Missouri State Superintedents Association Scholarship Application is due March 1st.

Essex Area Development Scholarship will be awarded to two students for \$500, which is due March 1st.

Missouri Bankers Foundation Scholarship must be postmarked by March 14th.


Peter Pasula Study Habits Scholarship has a deadline of April 1st and can be found online at www.mortgagebrokersburnaby.com
