Funeral services were then conducted at 2:30 P.M. in the Rainey-Mathis Funeral Chapel in Dexter with Rev. James Malloy officiating.

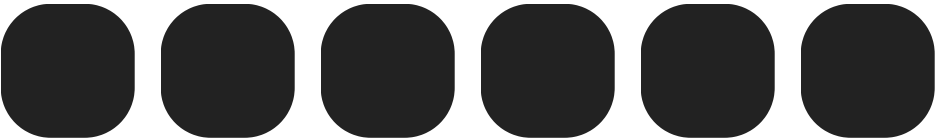
Interment followed in the Essex Cemetery.
