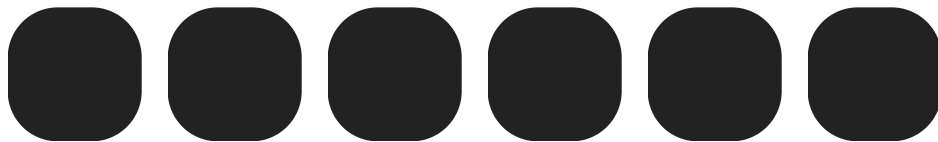

On Thursday, August 7th at 6:30 p.m. the Kindergarten will host an orientation until about 7:15 p.m.

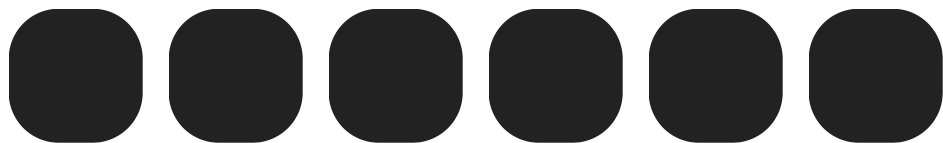
Then on Monday, August 11, 2014 Bernie Schools will host an Open House for grades 1st - 6th in the High School Gym at 6:00 p.m.

New Student Enrollment August 4th – 8th.

High School Band camp is Monday, Wednesday, and Friday from 8:00 a.m. – 10:00 a.m..

Junior High Band camp is Monday, Wednesday, and Friday from 10:00 a.m. – Noon.

Senior Registration is Wednesday, August 6th from 9:00 a.m. – Noon.

Junior Registration is Wednesday, August 6th from 1:00 p.m. – 3:00 p.m.

Sophomore Registration is Thursday, August 7th at 9:00 a.m. - Noon.

Freshman Registration is Thursday, August 7th is from 1:00 p.m. - 3:00 p.m.

Junior High School Registration (7th and 8th graders) is Friday, August 8th.

Grades 7 – 12 will need (1) notebook for each class, (1) folder for each class, pens and pencils for classes. Teachers will let parents and students know if additional supplies are required for a specific class.

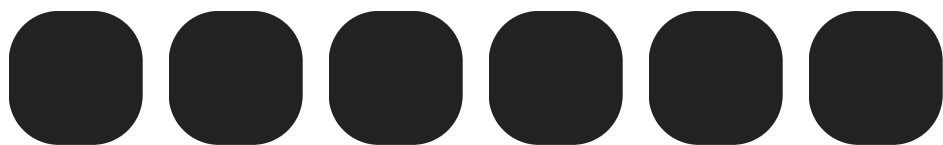
