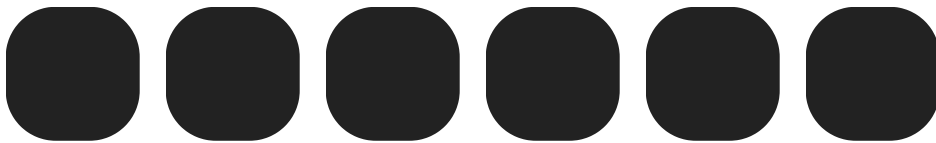

He was preceded in death by one sister, Daisy Breece and two brothers, Paul and Dale Ellis .

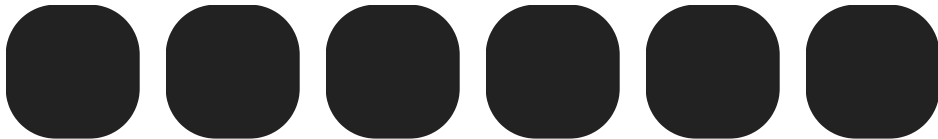
