**Dexter, Missouri** - Lacey Midgett is the daughter of David Midgett and Paula Stoker.

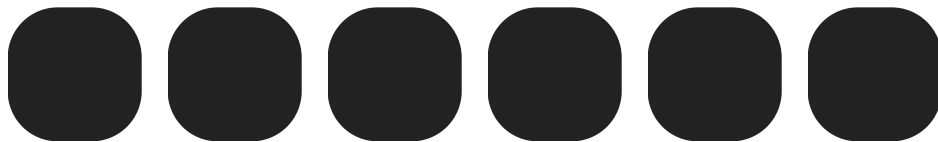

Teachers of America and the Dexter Honor Society. He also attended Missouri Boys State.

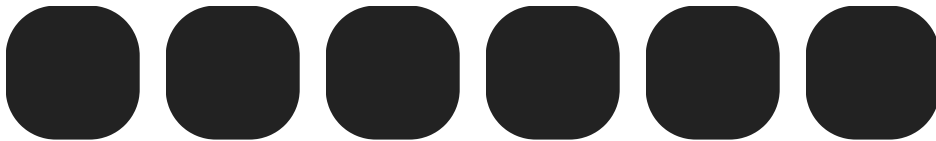
Brooks plans to attend Arkansas State University in Jonesboro and major in Nursing with a minor in Music.
