The Mules gave them quite a run, but it was top-seeded Dexter who edged Bernie 38-31 in a seesaw battle between two of the best middle school rivalries in southeast Missouri.

Dexter scored first, but Bernie answered with a 3-pointer putting them on top within seconds of the start of the first quarter. Both teams scored double digits

before moving on to the second period.

It was a seesaw battle throughout most of the game with fans sitting on the edge of their seats. "Seth has been steady all year handling the ball and had another great performance despite being in foul trouble," continued Dowdy. "I was really pleased with how well Joe played defensively also. he took care of a couple of their set plays and closed out on their shooters."

"Eric did not hit as many shots as he normally does, but he is always so composed which provides a calming effect for the rest of the guys."

"Nate is just gamer," stated Dowdy. "He does so many things right, we are just looking for him to attack more and once he does that he will be pretty tough to deal with on the offensive end."

Dowdy went on so say he felt Bernie played hard and they came to play. "I am glad we had to earn it, that's the way Championships should be won!"

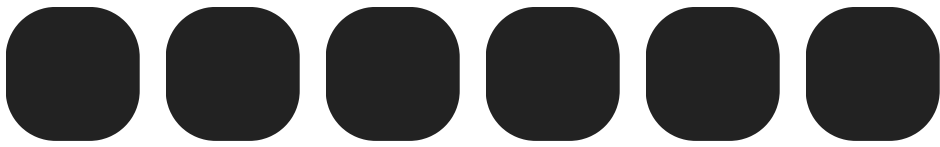

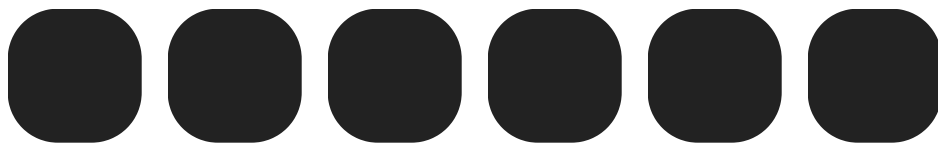
The Lady 'Cats will be back in action for their last game of the 2014 season when they travel to Sikeston on Thursday. Game time is 5:00 p.m.
