DHS Choir Performed Christmas is Coming Cantata




The First Christian Church will host their 8th Annual Cookie Walk from 9:00 a.m. - 11:00 a.m. on Saturday, December 6th.




At last year's event there were over 2,000 people in attendance and hopefully they will be able to double that this year!
