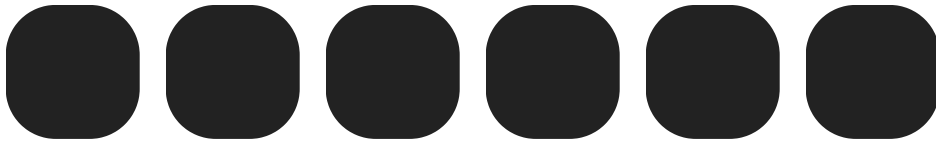
East Prairie played Holcomb at 10:00 a.m. on Saturday defeating them 70 – 41.

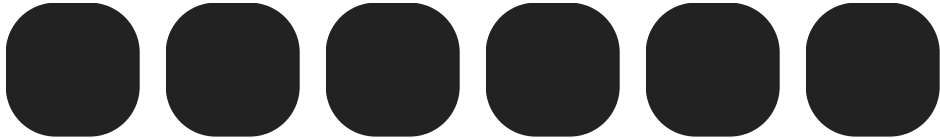
