She was preceded in death by one brother, Darrin Carter.

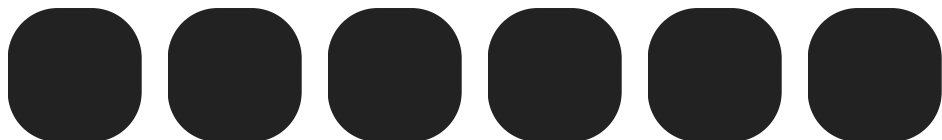
