Burial will be in the Bloomfield Cemetery with no graveside services. Watkins & Sons Funeral Service of Dexter, Missouri in charge of arrangements.

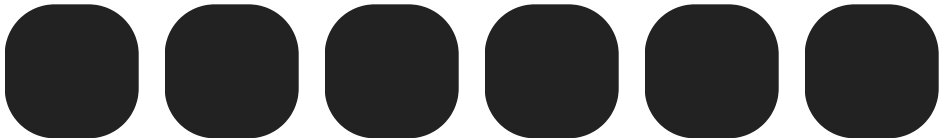
