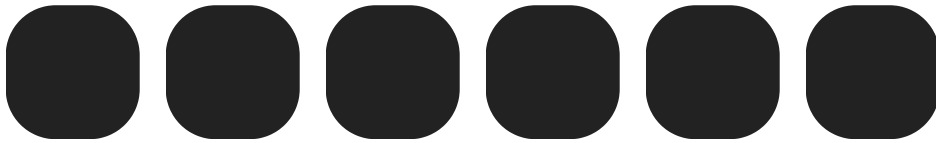

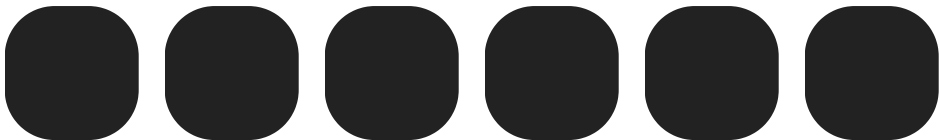

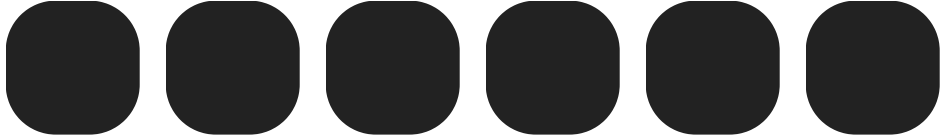
Lindsey's favorite cheer memory is dancing at the championship game of this year's Bloomfield Christmas Tournament.
