

- ... FLOOD WATCH IN EFFECT FROM MIDNIGHT CST TONIGHT THROUGH SATURDAY AFTERNOON...


• ... WINTER STORM WARNING IN EFFECT UNTIL 6 AM CST SATURDAY...

- THE NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE IN PADUCAH HAS ISSUED A WINTER STORM WARNING FOR SOUTHEAST MISSOURI... SOUTHERN ILLINOIS... SOUTHWEST INDIANA AND WEST KENTUCKY... WHICH IS IN EFFECT UNTIL 6 AM CST SATURDAY. THE WINTER WEATHER ADVISORY IS NO LONGER IN EFFECT.
- * TIMING: LATE THIS AFTERNOON THROUGH EARLY SATURDAY MORNING.





- * INCREDIBLY COLD ARCTIC AIR WITH RECORD SHATTERING LOW TEMPERATURES FORECAST WILL COMBINE WITH THE BRUTAL NORTH TO NORTHWEST WINDS BRINGING IT IN TO CREATE DANGEROUSLY COLD WIND CHILL READINGS TONIGHT.
- * TIMING... TONIGHT THROUGH MIDDAY THURSDAY.
- * WIND CHILL VALUES... BY SUNSET... BELOW ZERO. BY MIDNIGHT... 6 TO 18 BELOW ZERO. BY SUNRISE THURSDAY MORNING... 13 TO 24 BELOW ZERO.

- A WIND CHILL ADVISORY MEANS THAT VERY COLD AIR AND STRONG WINDS WILL COMBINE TO GENERATE WIND CHILLS OF 10 BELOW ZERO TO 25 BELOW ZERO. THIS WILL RESULT IN FROSTBITE AND LEAD TO HYPOTHERMIA IF PRECAUTIONS ARE NOT TAKEN. IF YOU MUST VENTURE OUTDOORS... MAKE SURE YOU WEAR A HAT AND GLOVES.
