Besides his parents, he was preceded in death by three brothers, Dennis Walker, Bobby Walker and Don Walker.

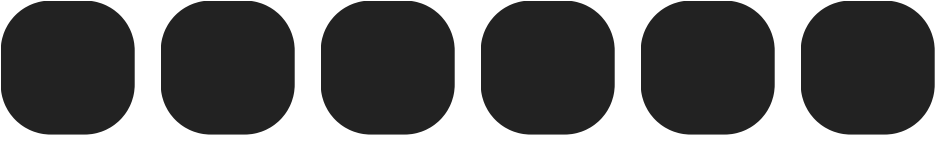
