MaKayla Waldner finished first in the 100-meter dash with a time of 12.95. She also placed first in the 100-meter hurdles with a time of 15.44, first in the 300-meter hurdles with a time of 45.78, and first in the long jump with a score of 16-1.

Hannah Moore took second in the 400-meter dash with a time of 1:06.45.

Kelsi Wood took second in the 800-meter dash with a time of 2:41.78.

Madelyn Webb placed third in shot put with a 30-9 1/2.

Taylor Ivy placed second play in the triple jump with a score of 31-4.

Cole Dean placed second in the 100-meter dash with a time of 12.24.

Dexter boys took second place in the 400 relay with a time of 49.81 and third in the 800 relay with a time of 1:43.78. In the 3,200 relay Dexter finished behind

Jackson and Cape for third with a time of 10:08.27.

Dexter girls took second in the 400 relay with a time of 58.02. They also took third in the 800 relay with a time of 2:03.64 and third in the 1,600 relay and 3,200 relay with times of 4:43.79 and 10:45.23.

"We are off to a great start," commented new head track and field coach Kim Waldner. "You never know what to expect for the first meet. There are always things that we see that we need to improve on and we will only get better."

"The first meet is a trial and error on the coaches part because there are some kids we never know how they will perform until the are thrown into a timed meet," continued Waldner. "Overall I'm looking forward to a great season."

"There are things we still need to work on," Pulley stated. "We were pulling out of our swing. We need to stay in there and be confident. We had a few mixups on the bases with signs. We have to be aware and pay attention to where we are on the bases."



Richland High School will host the SCAA Tournament this year on April 20th and 21st.


