Below are the results for the Dexter athletes who finished in the top eight in the competitions at Ste. Genevieve

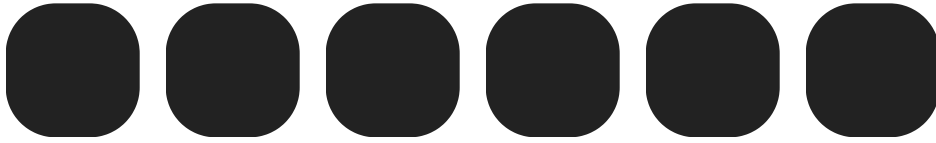

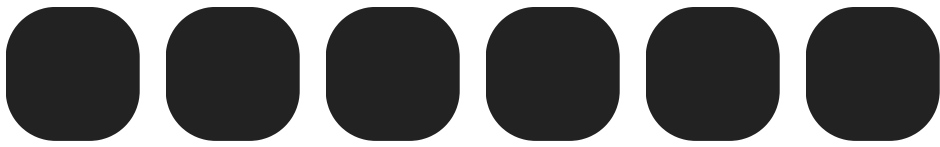

"It was a heads up play by Colton to get into scoring position," stated Becker. "He later scored on a sacrifice fly to right by Chandler Young."

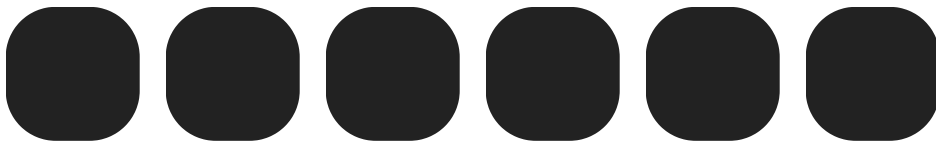
Dexter defeated Doniphan 5-0 in their season opener, lost to Malden on the road 18-7 and won at home against Kennett 16-12.

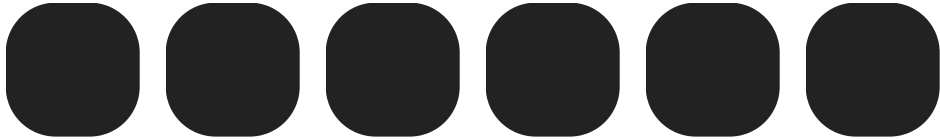
