MaKayla Waldner received First Place in Fibers/Collage Art.

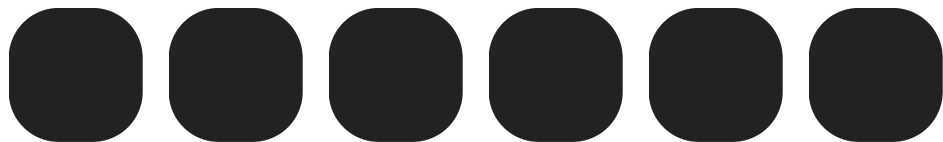
Reagan Miller took Second Place honors in the Portrait Art Division.

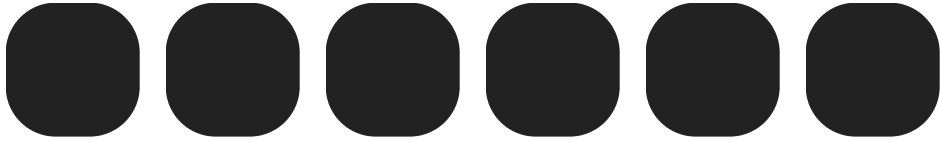
This event will be held at the middle school in Dexter and every test drive earns \$20 for their school. They have set a goal of \$6,000 and want to max that out!
