Waldner Wins Four Events, Webb Finishes First at Districts

Park Hills, Missouri – Freshman Madelyn Webb won the shot with a toss of 32-2.5 for the Lady Bearcats. She is the only underclassman to advance out of the districts in this event!

Dexter Lady 'Cats finished 2nd at Districts and several athletes have qualified for sectionals!

Junior athlete MaKayla Waldner won four events at the class 3, District 1 meet on Saturday. She won the 100-meter hurdles in 15.63 seconds, the 200 in 26.22 seconds, and the 300-hurdles in 53.93 seconds.

Waldner took first place in the long jump with a 16-feet, 9.75 inches. Taylor lvy came in second jumping 15 feet 7 inches and won the triple jump with a distance of 32-9.

Dalton Rickel took second in the triple jump with a leap of 38 - 3.5.

The Lady 'Cats advanced in all four relays finishing second in the 400 with a time of 55.31 and the 800 with a time of 1:55.26. They earned a fourth place finish in

the 1600 with a time of 4:35.95 and 3200 relay in 10:57. The boys took third place in the 800 relay with a time of 1:40.95 to advance to sectionals also.

Athletes who finish in the top four in each event earn a spot in the Class 3, Sectional 1 meet at Lutheran South High School on Saturday, May 23, 2015.
