Three Rivers College will hold five Fall registration events at locations across Southeast Missouri, July 27 through August 4.

Registration events will be held in Doniphan High School, 4-7 p.m. July 27; Three Rivers – Piedmont in Clearwater High School, 2-5 p.m. July 28; the Delta Center in Portageville,

10 a.m. – 2 p.m. July 29; the South Central Education Consortium in Willow Springs, 4-7 p.m. July 30; and at Three Rivers' new Sikeston location, 4-7 p.m. August 4.

There will also be a special COMPASS test session held at 9 a.m. on August 3 at the Sikeston location, 1400 S. Main in Sikeston. Assistance with financial aid paperwork will also be available at registration events.

Prospective students can search for classes online by going to trcc.edu, clicking on "myTRCC," followed by "Search for Classes."
