The students will work on music and marching and should meet at the T.S. Hill Middle School band room.

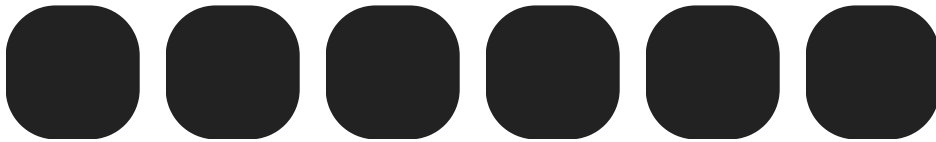

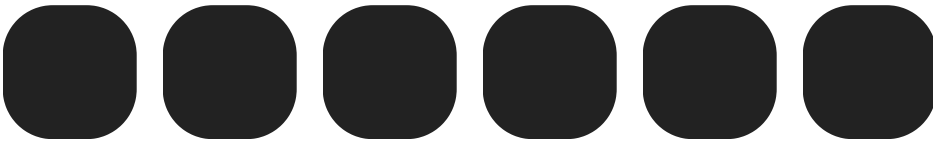
