Advisory Upgraded to Flash Flood Warning

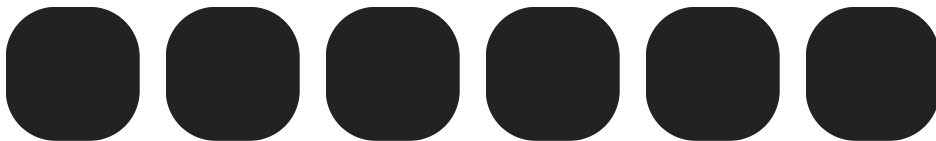

- \* AT 304 AM CDT... DOPPLER RADAR INDICATED REPEAT THUNDERSTORMS PRODUCING HEAVY RAIN ACROSS THE WARNED AREA. FLASH FLOODING IS EXPECTED TO BEGIN SHORTLY.
